# 3. NOTICE OF INADVERTENT AND UNINTENTIONAL ABSENCE AT BOONE COUNTY JOINT PUBLIC HEARING ON SEPTEMBER 19, 2023

\*PRESENTATION OF UPDATED PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX REQUEST IN REGARD TO THE ALLOWABLE GROWTH THRESHOLD

Treasurer Devine explained his absence at the Boone County Joint Public Hearing on September 19, 2023 was due to extreme illness. The City will hold its own property tax public hearing on October 10, 2023. Devine provided a report of the updated proposed property tax request and reviewed it with the council. The total property tax request will be changed from \$650,135.99 to \$615,813.99. The reduction will only affect the Debt Service Fund. Reducing the property tax request will decrease the budgeted Debt Service Cash Reserve from \$169,138 to \$135,156. The total assessed value of property has increased from last year to this year by 20.7 percent. A large amount of this is due to annexation. The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new assessed value of property, would be \$0.29.97 per \$100 of assessed value. The proposed property tax request would cause the tax rate to be \$0.30.58 per \$100 of assessed value. The City is well under the authority for levy limit. Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget for the City will increase by 49.83%. This includes all capital expenditures as well as operating expenses. No action taken.

**WHEREAS**, Nebraska Revised Statute 77-1601.02 and 77-1633 provides that the governing body of the City of Albion may set its property tax request by passing a resolution or ordinance setting the tax request by a majority vote; and,

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing was held as required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the proposed property tax request; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of the City of Albion that the property tax request for the current year to be a different amount than the property tax request for the prior year.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Governing Body of the City of Albion, by a majority vote, resolves that:

- 1. The 2023-2024 property tax request be set at:
  - a. General Fund: \$596,320.99;
  - b. Bond Fund: \$19,493.00;
- 2. The total assessed value of property differs from last year's total assessed value by 20.68%;
- 3. The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property, would be \$.299726 per \$100 of assessed value;
- 4. The City of Albion proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be \$.305821778 per \$100 of assessed value;
- 5. Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget of the City of Albion will increase from last year's by 49.83%;
- 6. A copy of this resolution and adopted budget statement be certified and forwarded to the County Clerk on or before October 15, 2023.

**WHEREAS**, Nebraska Revised Statute 13-511 provides that the governing body of the City of Albion may propose to revise the adopted budget statement due to circumstances which could not reasonably been anticipated at the time the budget for the current year was adopted; and,

**WHEREAS,** prior to approval of such revision the governing body of the City of Albion shall conduct a public hearing on such proposal to revise the adopted budget statement; and,

WHEREAS, upon conclusion of the public hearing on the proposed revised budget statement and approval of the proposed revised budget statement by the governing body of the City of Albion, the governing body shall file a copy of the revised budget, as adopted, with the County Clerk and with the State Auditor of Public Accounts; and,

**WHEREAS,** the governing body of the City of Albion, was inadvertently and unintentionally absent from the Boone County Joint Public Hearing on Proposed Property Tax Increases; and,

WHEREAS, due to the inadvertent and unintentional absence from the Boone County Joint Public Hearing on Proposed Property Tax Increases the governing body of the City of Albion held a separate Special Public Hearing to Set Final Tax Request on October 10, 2023; and,

**WHEREAS,** following the Special Public Hearing to Set Final Tax Request the governing body of the City of Albion adopted a final property tax request below the allowable growth limit percentage of 2.06%; and,

**WHEREAS,** the final property tax request approved and adopted by the governing body of the City of Albion is less than the amount specified on the original adopted 2023-24 budget statement; and,

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Albion has determined that an unanticipated revision to the adopted 2023-24 budget statement is now necessary due to the difference of the approved and adopted final property tax request from the property tax request amount specified in the original adopted 2023-24 budget statement; and,

WHEREAS, following the adoption of the final property tax request the governing body of the City of Albion held a properly noticed Public Hearing on the Proposed Revised Budget on October 10, 2023.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Governing Body of the City of Albion, by a majority vote, resolves that:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ALBION, NEBRASKA, AMENDING SECTION 2-117 REMOVING THE PROHIBITION AGAINST THE CARRYING OF CONCEALED WEAPONS WITHIN CITY LIMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBION, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 2-117 is repealed and replaced with the following:

SECTION 2-117: DISCHARGING FIREARMS AND OTHER SIMILAR WEAPONS PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful for any person, except a police officer in the performance of their duties, to discharge any firearm, airgun or slingshot loaded with rock or other dangerous missiles, within this city; provided, this section shall not apply to shooting galleries or other private shooting ranges within buildings or other structures approved by the Mayor and City Council. (Ref. Neb. Rev. Stat. § 17-556)

We're wrapping up the fiscal year and getting ready for annual audit scheduled for October 23<sup>rd</sup>.

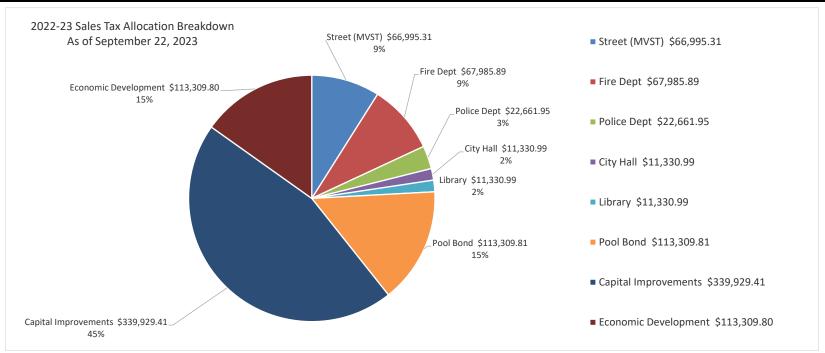

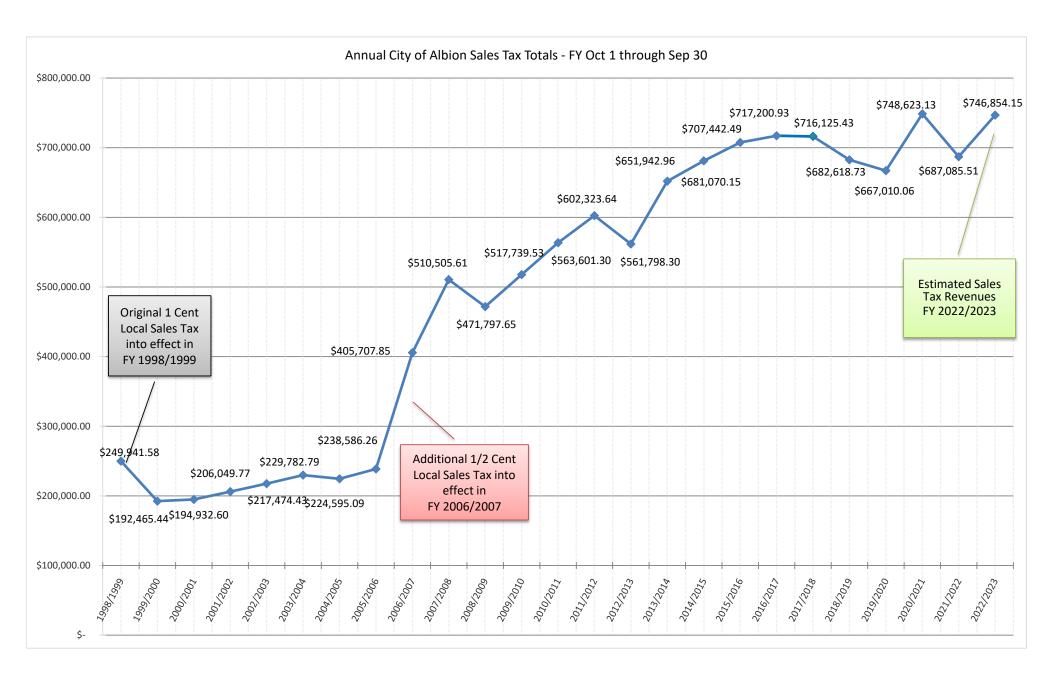
