**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN PURSUANT TO V.T.C.A., GOVERNMENT CODE, CHAPTER 551, THAT THE CITY COUNCIL FOR CITY OF ANGLETON WILL CONDUCT A MEETING, OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, ON TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 23, 2020, AT 6:00 P.M., AT THE CITY OF ANGLETON COUNCIL CHAMBERS LOCATED AT 120 S. CHENANGO STREET ANGLETON, TEXAS 77515.**

In accordance with an Order of the Office of the Governor issued March 16, 2020, this meeting scheduled is in person (**WEATHER PERMITTING**) and open to the public at The City of Angleton Council Chambers located at 120 S. Chenango Street Angleton, Texas 77515. In order to advance the public health goal of limiting face-to-face meetings (also called "social distancing") to slow the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19), seating will be limited to 50% Fire Code capacity or 24 people to allow for 6 feet of separation.

Citizens who wish to attend the Meeting in person must abide by the following requirements:

1. Do not enter the building if you are having symptoms. Go home.
2. Maintain a minimum distance of 6 feet from other citizens.
3. Families or persons traveling together may sit together but maintain social distancing from others.
