2. Discussion and possible action to amend approval of the TxDOT traffic controller cabinet art wrap submissions.

Jason O'Mara, Assistant Director of Parks & Recreation provided an update on the status of TxDOT Box wraps and inaccurate information that was provided at the March 20th meeting regarding the residency of artist submissions. As such, staff presented the board with the option to amend their previous approval to now include all three artists and the addition of a third location for installation. Motion made by Member Brewer to amend the previous approval of TxDOT Traffic Controller artwork submission and seconded by Member Demopulos. The motion passed with a 5-0 vote.

3. Discussion and possible action to support Keep Brazoria County Beautiful and keep access to Environmental Center Free of Charge.

Jason O'Mara, Assistant Director of Parks & Recreation provided information on the opportunity to partner with Keep Brazoria County Beautiful to allow residents continued access to the Environmental Center and various recycling services on the 2nd Saturday of every month. Motion made by Member Demopulos to approve the expense of \$1,268 to support Keep Brazoria County Beautiful and ensure free access to the Home Chemical Collection Site at Seabreeze and seconded by Member Dellinger. The motion passed with a 5-0 vote.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

KAB Pop-up Clean-up: With remining funds from the H-GAC Solid Waste Grant, Keep Angleton Beautiful had the opportunity to host an additional event on August 12th, the KAB Pop-up Cleanup. This two-part event included a community trash cleanup on two main roads in Angleton and access to electronic recycling, paper shredding, and tire recycling. The following provided some data results from the event.

- Total # of Volunteer 10
- Total Volunteer Hours 21
- Trash Collected 150 lbs.
- Tires Recycled 52
- Electronic Recycling 1,987 lbs.
- Event traffic 68 vehicles

TxDOT Box Wraps: Installation of the next round of box wraps is scheduled to take place by end of August. Specific locations and artist information in outline below.

- Cannan & Loop 274 Show Me a Sign Joy Chandler
- Cedar & Bus 288 Melissa Jacobson
- Locust & Loop 274 Texas Wildflowers Heather Pizzitola

Green Ribbon Project/Loop 274/BUS288 Median Landscaping: Staff are continuing to be included on updated from TxDOT's on the Green Ribbon Project. Although the project will impact various communities surrounding Angleton, the impact to our areas including medians along 288B and Loop 274. Highlights from the most recent pre-construction meeting are below.

- The project will begin in January 2024.
- Yellowstone is the contractor completing the work and will have 7 months to complete.

- Work is being completed in Friendswood, Alvin, Angleton, Richwood, and Surfside.
- TxDOT has requested a schedule so cities can be notified when contractors will be working in their community.
- Contractor is required to notify TxDOT 24 hours in advance if there will be any lane closures (we'll be impacted on Loop 274)
- TxDOT has offered to replace dying crepe myrtles in the two northern medians on Loop 274.

Fall Events/Programs

- **Texas Arbor Day Tree Planting:** Staff are working with Trees for Houston to secure trees for planting in various City Parks on Friday, November 3rd at 8:00am. Volunteers are welcome to participate and support our initiative in continuing to beautify our local parks. Specific planting locations TBD.
- **Fall Sweep:** Initial planning has begun for Fall Sweep in November with a tentative date of Saturday, November 4th. Current plans include heavy trash disposal, electronic recycling, tire recycling, paper shredding, paint recycling, household chemical collections, flag collection, eye glass collection, and tree giveaway. Also, staff are planning to incorporate a community cleanup to pick up trash throughout town when collections are taking place.
- Adopt-a-Spot: The new adopt a spot program will kick-off providing an opportunity for
 individuals, groups, clubs, organizations, etc. to help keep Angleton beautiful. Staff have
 identified various hotspots throughout town that need a little extra attention and
 volunteers will be provided with options based on the group size and ease of access to
 clean up these hotspots. Supplies are provided by KAB and volunteers will receive social
 media recognition for their support.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff have prepared proposed budgets for Keep Angleton Beautiful for the fiscal year 2023-2024.

Below is a listing of notable budgetary changes:

Revenue

- Trash Bag Revenue
 - Increased by \$1,000.
- Water Bill Donations
 - Increased budgeted revenue by \$8,000 due to full year at \$1.00 donation amount.
- Donations
 - o Increased by \$3,050 for event sponsorships.

Expenses

- Cleanup Costs
 - Increased by \$3,394 as H-GAC has ended and to include community cleanups with Fall Sweep and Spring Cleanup. Adding Adopt-a-spot program.
- Capital Expense
 - Increased by \$6,221 to cover the cost of replacing an additional park entry sign.
- Capital Equipment
 - Decreased by \$25,200. Soofa sign was purchased for Bates Park in FY22-23, no plan for additional Soofa signs at this time.

Staff is seeking approval of the Keep Angleton Beautiful budget for fiscal year 2023-2024.
