### REGULAR AGENDA

1. Approve the minutes of the Senior Citizen Commission meeting of June 3, 2024.

Upon a motion by Member Shaw and seconded by Member Phillips, the Commission approved the minutes from the June 3, 2024, meeting. The motion passed with a vote of 5-0.

2. Discussion on Cost Recovery Policy proposed updates

The Recreation Superintendent presented the current Angleton Parks & Recreation Department policy on Cost Recovery. Staff have been asked to review the current policy by city council and consider indirect costs along with the already considered direct costs. When the policy was adopted in 2020, all senior programs were to have a 0%+ cost recovery. The commission was presented with keeping most senior programs as a Tier 1: Mostly Community Benefit and moving senior trips and overnight trips to a Tier 2: Considerable Community Benefit with a 25% cost recovery. Member Aschenbeck made a recommendation to not consider a 25% cost recovery on senior day trips and overnight trips, but rather consider a fuel charge on these trips.

3. Discussion and possible action on an alternative trip option for the 2024 October – 2025 September Senior Lunch & Trip Plan

The approved 2024 October -2025 September Senior Lunch & Trip plan had the Silver Hearts attending a “Murder Mystery Dinner Theatre in June 2025. Due to scheduling issues, an alternative trip needs to take its place. Staff presented the commission with an additional alternative trip plan to the Naskila Casino in Livingston, TX for June 2025. This alternative trip fits within the senior programs current budget and the casino will also provide transportation to allow us to take 53 participants. Upon a motion by Member Milam and seconded by Member McDaniel, the Commission approved the alternative trip option for the 2024 October – 2025 September Senior Lunch & Trip Plan. The motion passed with a vote of 4-1.

Discussion on Strategic Plan updates.

The Recreation Superintendent presented updates of the Strategic Plan.
