1. Approve the minutes of the Senior Citizen Commission meeting of August 2, 2021.

Upon a motion by Member McDaniel and seconded by Member Aschenbeck, the Commission approved the minutes from the August 02, 2021 meeting. The motion passed with a vote of 4-0.

2. Discussion on senior programming survey results.

Geri Gonzales, Recreation Superintendent, provided the commission with results from the Senior Programs and senior trip destination survey that was conducted in July 2021. Geri provided survey results and recommendations for future field trips and programs based on the survey data that was collection.

3. Discussion on Strategic Plan updates.

Geri Gonzales, Recreation Superintendent, provided the commission with updates for the Senior Commission's Strategic Plan. Strategic Plan updates included recent information about housing, transportation, health care, legislative, recreation, and quality of life. 4. Discussion on senior citizen recreational programs and leisure events.

Geri Gonzales, Recreation Superintendent, provided updates about Senior programming provided by Angleton Parks and Recreation. The updates included registration being opened for programs happening between October-December, information on new programs being offered, information on upcoming field trips, and highlights of new events that will be offered during the period.

5. Discussion on existing and future Angleton developments.

Lindsay Koskiniemi, Assistant Director of Development Services, presented information on current housing developments within Angleton. Chris Whittaker, City Manager, fielded questions from the Senior Commission on city work related to water capacity and availability of housing for seniors.

6. Discussion on Hurricane Nicholas response.

Geri Gonzales, Recreation Superintendent, provided updates about the Parks and Recreation Department's response to Hurricane Nicholas. These updates included work that was completed as part of immediate response to storm cleanup, the assessment damage at the Angleton Recreation Center, the Angleton Recreation Center being activated as a cooling center for the community, and special efforts to aid seniors within Angleton.


RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the Senior Citizen Commission approve the 2022 Senior Citizen Strategic Plan objectives and strategies as presented.




Q1 What age range do you fall into?


