NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN PURSUANT TO V.T.C.A., GOVERNMENT CODE, CHAPTER 551, THAT THE CITY COUNCIL FOR CITY OF ANGLETON WILL CONDUCT A MEETING, OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, ON TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 23, 2020, AT 6:00 P.M., AT THE CITY OF ANGLETON COUNCIL CHAMBERS LOCATED AT 120 S. CHENANGO STREET ANGLETON, TEXAS 77515.

In accordance with an Order of the Office of the Governor issued March 16, 2020, this meeting scheduled is in person (**WEATHER PERMITTING**) and open to the public at The City of Angleton Council Chambers located at 120 S. Chenango Street Angleton, Texas 77515. In order to advance the public health goal of limiting face-to-face meetings (also called "social distancing") to slow the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19), seating will be limited to 50% Fire Code capacity or 24 people to allow for 6 feet of separation.

Citizens who wish to attend the Meeting in person must abide by the following requirements:

1. Do not enter the building if you are having symptoms. Go home.
2. Maintain a minimum distance of 6 feet from other citizens.
3. Families or persons traveling together may sit together but maintain social distancing from others.

RESOLUTION NO. 20210223-001

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS, RATIFYING THE DISASTER DECLARATION SIGNED BY THE MAYOR ON FEBRUARY 15, 2021 AND CONSENTING TO ITS CONTINUATION THROUGH MARCH 16, 2021; REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS; INCLUDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on February 15, 2021, Mayor Jason Perez, acting in accordance with authority granted to him under Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code and the City's Home Rule Charter, declared a local state of disaster for the City due to damages caused by an intense winter storm system that brought record cold temperatures, freezing conditions including severe ice, and snow, harsh weather conditions, and prolonged, widespread power outages; and

WHEREAS, Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code the City of Angleton, consenting to the renewal and continuation of the declaration of disaster for thirty days; and

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating the disaster declaration continue to exist; and

WHEREAS, the City Council supports the disaster declaration signed by Mayor Jason Perez on February 15, 2021 and consents to its continuation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The facts and recitations contained in the preamble of this Resolution are hereby found and declared to be true and correct and are incorporated by reference herein and expressly made a part hereof, as if copied verbatim.

SECTION 2. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the City of Angleton, Texas pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code, and the City Council hereby consents to its continuation through March 15, 2021, or until such time as it is terminated by the Mayor provided that the Mayor gives City Council seventy-two hours' notice of proposed termination.

SECTION 3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

SECTION 4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the City emergency management plan.

SECTION 5. The Mayor is authorized to sign this Resolution and the City Secretary to attest.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall become effective and be in full force and effect upon execution by the Mayor.

DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER

PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS

WHEREAS, the City of Angleton, Brazoria County, Texas is expected to suffer widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of property resulting from an intense winter storm system that is expected to bring record cold temperature, freezing conditions including severe ice, and snow, harsh weather conditions, and prolonged, widespread power outages, and other public calamity resulting there from, which requires emergency action; and

WHEREAS, Governor Abbott declared a state disaster declaration on February 13, 2020 which included Brazoria County, and has received an Emergency Declaration from President Biden and FEMA for Public Assistance Category B (Emergency Protective Measures), Direct Federal Assistance, and Hazard Mitigation statewide; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of Angleton; Jason Perez, has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property, roads, and parks, and

WHEREAS, the City of Angleton Emergency Management Plan should be activated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF ANGLETON, BRAZORIA COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the City of Angleton, Brazoria County, Texas pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

2. The Mayor, as Director of Emergency Management, is hereby authorized to provide, or cause to be provided, all arrangements, provisions and means necessary and proper to effect coordination of relief, and property restoration for the protection, preservation, and improvement of life and property within the City during the State of Emergency.

2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Mayor and City Council of Angleton, Texas.

3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the recovery and rehabilitation aspects of all applicable local or interjurisdictional emergency management plans and authorized the furnishing of all aid and assistance as deemed necessary or desirable by those administering such plans, and activates the preparedness and response aspects of the City of Angleton emergency management plan, and any other such plans.

5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
