Motion made by Commissioner Hodson, Seconded by Commissioner Eaton.

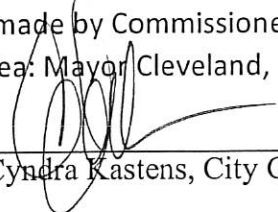
