### RESOLUTION NO. 2021-07-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ARKANSAS CITY, KANSAS REGARDING THE GOVERNING BODY'S INTENT TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE.

**WHEREAS**, the Revenue Neutral Rate for the City of Arkansas City, KS was calculated as 66.863 mills by the Cowley County Clerk; and

**WHEREAS**, the budget proposed by the Governing Body of the City of Arkansas City, KS will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body intends to hold a hearing and hear testimony from all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard as required by state law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ARKANSAS CITY, KANSAS:

**SECTION ONE:** The Governing Body of the City of Arkansas City, KS hereby sets a public hearing regarding its intention to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate for September 7, 2021 at 5:30 p.m. to be held at City Hall, 118 W Central Ave, Arkansas City, KS and directs that notice of the public hearing be given as required by state law.

**SECTION TWO:** The Governing Body of the City of Arkansas City, KS expresses its intention to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate with a proposed mill levy of \_\_\_\_\_\_ mills.

**SECTION THREE:** The Governing Body of the City of Arkansas City, KS directs the City Clerk to provide this resolution to the Cowley County Clerk as notice of the City's proposed intent to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

**SECTION FOUR:** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from its date of passage by the Governing Body of the City of Arkansas City, Kansas.
