He stated the guys did a great job handing the situation and getting it resolved quickly. He discussed the leak issues with the Municipal Building roof and the bid he is working on getting for a membrane liner to correct this. Mayor further discussed a property that is going up for auction next to the City Hall build site and stated it would be a great spot for employee parking and another exit. He further stated he would like to discuss purchasing this property further at the Workshop Meeting.
