Partner reports	Soccer – Renee Cannon reported soccer will begin on 3/15/25 and end on 5/17/25. There are 23/kids signed up.  Baseball – AC Clark reported baseball is starting practice on Saturday.
Parks report	AC Clark reported that everything is turned into TDOT and RJ Corman. He reported we are waiting on RJ Corman for one more item then it can be put out to bid in April. They are hoping to start in August 2025 and finish in August 2026.  Valerie VanOstenbridge asked what the one thing we are missing. AC Clark reported they are waiting for a public report for railroad use or we can go on without it per TDOT. He reported that since the railroad hasn't been used since the 70s there shouldn't be an issue. TDOT will continue with the process and if the public report is needed the city will provide it.

2025 Park Activities	Michael Smith reported that the mayor would like to do an Arts event in April/May 2026.  Valerie VanOstenbridge reported she would like to do a heritage festival. This would hopefully pull in first responders to do safety lessons/skills, churches to do bake sales and schools do arts for the kids and nonprofits would have info on their missions. Have local business have booths to promote their business. We could do 3 legged races, egg races, turtle races and any other friendly competitive races. Bucket brigade buckets, since Ashland City burned down 2 or 3 times before we had a fire department. Mayor could give a key to city each year to an individual who excelled in the town. Valerie VanOstenBridge will work on getting representatives from the organizations around town to see who is interested and what we can do for the next meeting then we can split up the list and invite them to our April meeting.
