I am pleased to provide your department with the following sole source letter. Advanced Covert Technology, Inc. is the sole provider of the equipment on the following equipment quotation (ACT TCV-514 Tiger Cam Video Surveillance System with Wireless Broadband IP). ACT is the sole distributor of the ACT TCV-514 Tiger Cam as well as the sole provider in marketing the ACT TCV-514 Tiger Cam. This product is unmatched by any of our competitors due to the components which are used to manufacture them. They are also unmatched due to their design and specifications. ACT is the only company you can purchase the ACT TCV-514 Tiger Cam from.

No company uses a Multifunctional Tiger Cam Bracket for perfect camera mounting. No Company has a design which gives the camera full access to the viewing area. No company uses dual antennas to maximize the cellular range and connectivity in poor cellular service area. The Tiger Cam also comes complete with an upgraded 4G/LTE provisioned cellular modem at no additional cost.

The covert camera IP system must be configured as a standalone surveillance system that can be installed at a surveillance location with minimal effort and time by connecting the "IP" PTZ Utility Box to a wall, round pole, or square pole.

The Enviro Climate Control and reset allows the operator to have a box that will not fog up in extreme weather conditions.
