ADMINISTRATIVE 1 FISCAL MATTERS

Resolution to Adopt the 2023 Millage Rate and Accept the Board of Education Resolution

Assistant County Manager Dawn Hudson presented a Resolution for the Board's consideration establishing the County Millage Rates for Tax Year 2023. She reported all legal requirements have been met for advertising the five (5) year tax digest and levy history; notice has been given that the County tax levy would be presented for adoption at this called meeting. Ms. Hudson stated the County's tax levy for 2023 is 10.02 mills and sets the rate for the Hospital Indigent Care Tax District at \$25.

She confirmed the Board of Education met earlier and adopted the BOE millage rate of 14.58 mills which is also included in this Resolution for adoption.

Assistant County Manager Hudson requested a vote to accept the Resolution as presented to set the 2023 millage rate at the rollback rate of 10,02 and to authorize the Chairman to execute the Resolution.

Commissioner Sammy Hall made a motion to adopt the Resolution as presented. Commissioner Henry Craig seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

RESOLUTION FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF MILLAGE RATES FOR THE 2023 TAX DIGEST

A RESOLUTION TO SET THE 2023 MILLAGE RATE FOR UNINCORPORATED AND INCORPORATED BALDWIN COUNTY, GEORGIA, FOR THE BALDWIN COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION, AND FOR THE HOSPITAL-BASED INDIGENT CARE SERVICES SPECIAL TAX DISTRICT; TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY CLERK TO FILE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Baldwin County, Georgia ("County") is a political subdivision of the State of Georgia and is charged with providing public services 10 local residents; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. 48-5-32, the Baldwin County Board of Commissioners caused proper notice to appear in the legal organ of the County to report the Current 2023 Tax Digest and 5-Year History ofLevy;

WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. 48-5-32, said notice indicated that the Baldwin County Board of Commissioners would establish the millage rate at a meeting on August 22, 202.3 at 4:00 pm in the Commissioners' Meeting Room located at 1601 N Columbia Street, Suite 220, Milledgeville, Georgia;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board or Commissioners of Baldwin County, Georgia, and it is hereby resolved by authority of the same, as follows:

1. Setting of the 2023 Millage Rates. The Board does hereby establish millage rates for all Baldwin County tax districts for the 2023 tax digest as tbl]ows:

Baldwin County Unincorporated Board of Commissioners: Gross unincorporated millage rate of 10.02 mills as the unincorporated millage rate for the Board of Commissioners.

Baldwin County Incorporated Board of Commissioners: Gross incorporated millage rale of 10.02 mills as the incorporated milage rate tor the Board of Commissioners.

Baldwin County Board of Education: Upon the recommendation of the Baldwin County Board of Education, a millage rate of 14.58 mills.

Hospital-Based Indigent Care Services Special Tax District: A fee amount of \$25.00 in accordance with Resolution adopted June 28, 2018 by BOC to establish special district.

- 2. Authorization of County Clerk. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the County Clerk to tile any and all documents with the Departmenl of Revenue or other entities which die necessary to elTcctua{c this Resolution and 10 record this Resolution In the official minutes of the County.
- 3. Severability (n case any one or more of the provisions of this resolution shall [or any reason be held to be illegal Ol' invaEid, such illegality or invaiidily shall not affect any other provision of this resolution, but this resolution shan be construed and enforced as if such illegal or invalid provision had not been contained herein.
- 4. Repeal of Conflicting Resolutions. Any and all resolutions in conflict with thlS resolution this day passed be and they are hereby repealed.
- 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shail take effect immediately upon its adoption
