It is not necessary to announce yourself when you join the teleconference. The public will be permitted to offer public comments during the meeting only if a public hearing required by law has been published. A recording of the telephone conference will be made and will be available to the public in accordance with the Open Meetings Act.

1. Call to order.

2. Invocation and Pledge.

3. Visitors to be heard (shall not exceed 30 minutes total).

Citizens wishing to be heard may do so on all matters except personnel matters, matters listed on the agenda as a public hearing, and matters under litigation. Citizens who prefer to speak at the time the agenda item is called may do so with the Mayor's approval. Each person addressing the council must provide his/her legal name and current address for city records and meeting minute preparation. Each person will only be allowed to speak on matters on the agenda during citizen's forum/public comment. No rebuttals will be permitted. Each person addressing the governing body shall not exceed three (3) minutes. Section 551.042, Government Code, V.T.C.A. (i.e. Texas Open Meetings Act) permits a member of the public or a member of the governmental body to raise a subject that has not been included in the notice for the meeting, but any discussion of the subject must be limited to a proposal to place the subject on the agenda for a future meeting. All remarks shall be addressed to the council as a body, and not to any individual member thereof. Any person making personal, impertinent, or slanderous remarks while addressing the council may be requested to leave the meeting.

4. Consent Agenda.

A. Approval of the minutes from the January 11, 2022 meeting.

5. Closed Session.

A. The City of Bandera will meet in closed session as authorized by Texas Government Code §551.071, Personnel Matters and Section 551.071, Consultation with Attorney, to hear and deliberate regarding a complaint or charge against an officer of the City; to wit: Councilmember Darcy Hasty's alleged conduct that could be in violation of the City Code Section 1.03.255 Conduct of city officials and employees which states that "the professional and personal conduct of city officials and employees shall refrain from abusive conduct, personal charges or verbal attacks upon the character or motives of other city officials and employees, board, commission, and committee members and the public."

Councilmember Hasty may request that such matter be discussed in open session other than the time necessary for the Council to receive advice from legal counsel on this matter where the duty of the attorney to the governmental body under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas clearly conflicts with the Texas Open Meetings Act.

B. The City of Bandera will meet in closed session pursuant to Texas Government Code Section 551.072, deliberations about real property, to wit: an update from Rob Brown of Texas Land and Right-of-Way on land acquisition for the wastewater treatment plant location.

6. Action following Closed Session.

- A. Action that may be taken by City Council following the closed or open deliberation by City Council on closed session item 5 A are as follows:
 - i. The City Council may determine that no further action is merited.

ii. The City Council may determine that further consideration or investigation is needed to postpone the matter for consideration at a later date.

iii. The City Council, pursuant to City Code Section 1.03.271 Compliance and Enforcement, impose sanctions, such as reprimand, formal censure, or loss of committee assignment, if it is determined that Councilmember Hasty has violated the City Council Code of Ethics.
