AGENDA

1. Call to order.

2. Visitors to be Heard (shall not exceed 30 minutes total).

Citizens wishing to be heard may do so on all matters except personnel matters, matters listed on the agenda as a public hearing, and matters under litigation. Each person addressing the council must provide his/her legal name and current address for city records and meeting minute preparation. Each person will only be allowed to speak on matters on the agenda during citizen's forum/public comment. No rebuttals will be permitted. Each person addressing the governing body shall not exceed three (3) minutes. Section 551.042, Government Code, V.T.C.A. (i.e. Texas Open Meetings Act) permits a member of the public or a member of the governmental body to raise a subject that has not been included in the notice for the meeting, but any discussion of the subject must be limited to a proposal to place the subject on the agenda for a future meeting. All remarks shall be addressed to the council as a body, and not to any individual member thereof. Any person making personal, impertinent, or slanderous remarks while addressing the council may be requested to leave the meeting.

3. Closed Session:

- A. The City Council will meet in closed session pursuant to Texas Government Code Section 551.071 to consult with legal counsel regarding any legal questions related to options available to the City Council for removal of officers under Texas Local Government Code Chapter 22.
- B. The City Council will meet in closed session pursuant to Texas Government Code Section 551.074, personnel, to deliberate the employment, evaluation, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee; to wit: City Marshal. The City Marshal may request a public hearing.

4. Action after Closed Session – Discussion and possible action on one or more of the following items:

- A. Consideration and possible action on a Resolution removing the City Marshal due to City Council lack of confidence in the City Marshal. To be effective, this Resolution must receive an affirmative vote by two-thirds of the elected aldermen.
- B. Consideration and possible action on a Resolution removing the City Marshal for incompetency, corruption, misconduct, or malfeasance in office. The City Marshal has a right to speak before any consideration of this Resolution.
- C. Consideration and possible action on a Resolution appointing an Interim City Marshal.

5. Adjourn.
