1. Call to order.

 - 1. Consideration, discussion, and possible action on a request by Shawn Pickrell owner of Lowe's Market at 907 Main Street, Bandera, Texas, for a 112-square foot variance from the maximum square footage allowed for commercial wall signs under the terms of the Bandera Code of Ordinances Sec. 3.09.012.

Carter Thurman, from Comet Signs, and present for Shawn Pickrell, explained to the board Lowe's is updating the faces of the signs, or refacing, rather than erected new signage. This goes along with the remodel currently underway in the building.

Motion to approve the variance as stated. Motion made by Hasty, Seconded by Kunz. There was discussion about the current sign ordinance and getting existing signs to come into compliance. There is also discussion about the pervious sign variances requested and granted by other businesses and how it may not be fair to deny Lowe's.

There was discussion about the process to update the signs. Mr. Thurman explains there is no alteration to the signs other than the refacing. The structure will not be altered. There is continued discussion about approving the variances because of past variances granted.
