- -Explains how this will be franchising off of another business located in Cleveland, GA. They have been in business 16 years.
- -No smell
- -No equipment

- -No space, ran with a swimming pool pump
- -No Ambers
- -No traffic on road but hers, 24 hour service
- -Would like to expand in future

In Favor

Rick Farmer Cleveland, GA

- -Owner of the original business
- -Has 6 incinerators
- -16 years in business and no complaints
- -Came from Burnese Indiana
- -Very Little heat trail
- -No smell, Includes a after burner that breaks the smell

In Opposition

Beatrice Samples 304 Lakeview Drive

- -Has a swimming pool worried about ashes and smell
- -Asked about property values and taxes

Board Member Mr. Hensley asked about the 12X12 metal building is where it will be stored. It only has a metal top and posts.

Ms. Mobley explained that it will be metal from the ground up. She also explained how she would operate under the franchise's state license.

Chairman O'Kelly asked if EPD would have to approve or a certification required.

Mr. Farmer said no.

Board Member Mr. Wheatley asked where Mr. Farmers business was located and about the Georgia Burn Ban.

Mr. Farmer stated that they burn propane and it all burns clean.

Board Member Mr. Hensley asked about the expansion plan.

Ms. Mobley explained that most of her customers would come from a vet's office. Once the area is outgrown she would want to expand to a bigger place.

Chairman O'Kelly discussed the fire chief and how a chain link fence would be needed for protection.

Vice Chairman Griffith asked about the cleanup.

Ms. Mobley told him just a broom and pan.

Board Member Jody Parks asked if they would be on the premises while it is running.

Ms. Mobley stated yes, only 3.5 hours run time average.

Conditions suggested by planning board:

1. Limited to 2 Incinerator's on the property

- 2. Compliant with the GA Department of Agriculture, EPA & EPD standards. Fire Department Codes on Burn Bans.
- 3. 12X12 Area with roof surrounded by a a 6ft chain link fence/barrier.
- 4. Pad should consist of the specs that the incinerator company suggests to use.
