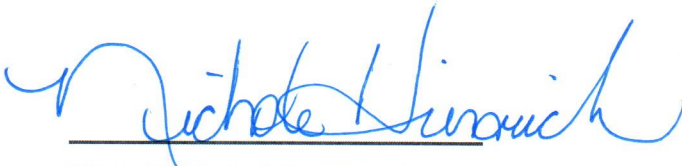

Topic / Description: While I am a county resident, I regularly travel into Bastrop to shop, dine, work, and support local businesses. Because neighboring communities share roads, economic ties, and public infrastructure, decisions made by this council directly impact those of us across the county line. I am writing to urge the City Council to re-evaluate and terminate the city's contract with Flock Safety. While proponents often point to internal department policies to justify these systems, critical structural issues make those local guardrails ineffective in practice: 1. Local Policies are Rendered Void by Network Sharing: The council can enact strict local guidelines for our officers, but those internal rules are effectively rendered meaningless the moment nationwide network sharing is enabled. Once local cameras feed into a shared regional or national pool, officers in outside jurisdictions operating under entirely different standards can access, search, and track vehicles passing through Bastrop. Local policy cannot govern out of jurisdiction agencies. 2. Mass Data Exposure ("Have I Been Flocked?"): The public transparency website Have I Been Flocked? has cataloged nearly a quarter-billion Flock search records obtained through public records requests. Including Bastrop's data. This tool demonstrates how easily driver location histories, query records, and search activity are leaked and permanently archived online, exposing the travel patterns of law-abiding commuters. 3. Surveillance of Neighboring Visitors: County residents who commute into Bastrop have their movements logged into a system without opt-out mechanisms or consent, treating every visiting neighbor as a potential suspect. As a neighboring Bastrop County resident who regularly supports the City Of Bastrop's economy, I ask the council to prioritize privacy, data security, and regional trust by voting to cancel the Flock Safety contract. OPEN LETTER TO THE CITY OF BASTROP

TO: Mayor Ishmael Harris, Bastrop City Council, City Manager Sylvia Carrillo, and the Bastrop Law Enforcement Agency

DATE: August 24, 2026

A Call for the immediate termination of contracts and usage of Unmanned Surveillance and Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) Deployments, and AI-driven mass surveillance networks.

These automated pattern-recognition systems represent a profound legal, financial, and operational liability to local municipalities and law enforcement agencies. Rather than acting as localized safety tools, third-party camera pools create warrantless digital dragnets that expose local governments to major civil rights lawsuits, breach evolving statutory privacy protections, and erode public trust by converting municipal property into nodes of continuous surveillance owned by 3rd party Hyper-Scaled Corporations.

Public outrage is rising around the country and is being acknowledged at the highest levels; municipalities and law enforcement agencies are facing growing legislative & regulatory liabilities.

Representatives Tim Burchett (R-TN) & Thomas Massie (R-KY) have both recently introduced pro-privacy legislation:

Federal Procurement & Funding Penalties (H.R. 9800): As detailed in federal filings, the Protection Against Mass Surveillance Act directly targets commercial camera platforms like Flock Safety by prohibiting federal agencies from operating automated tracking tools and stripping federal grant funding from local police departments that maintain mass camera networks.

Constitutional Warrant Restraints (H.R. 1466): Reasserting Fourth Amendment protections against mass surveillance, the Surveillance State Repeal Act introduced by Rep. Thomas Massie establishes that gathering or querying domestic location logs without an individualized probable-cause warrant constitutes an unconstitutional search.,

We demand that the City of Bastrop take immediate action to cease and desist and end all contracts, obligations, and usage of unmanned surveillance systems and ALPR devices; specifically on city buildings or controlled properties.

Protecting our community requires leadership that honors constitutional rights, shields public funds from mounting legal liabilities, and maintains the trust of the residents you serve.
