I. CALL TO ORDER: 6:13pm by Jennifer Long

II. CITIZEN COMMENTS: None

III. MINUTE APPROVAL:

- this one. One change is we will not be using the library parking lot for the Trunk or Treat, we will use Spring to Farm Street (will be shut down).
- D. Economic Vitality Committee Update: Parklet Program still in the works, quotes are coming in regarding the parking analysis in hopes to get a parking garage. Reinvestment Grant Partner with EDC and ask to fund this grant.
