SUBJECT: Lynn Eury – Donation to the Committee

BRIEF SUMMARY:

Mr. Lynn Eury has offered a donation of \$10,000 for members of the Harbor Management Committee to travel as a group along the eastern seaboard to gather lessons learned and best practices for harbor management and preserving the historic nature of Beaufort. There are some logistics associated with the use of these funds that need to be discussed and addressed during the August meeting. Those items are as follows:

- Travel Time - Mr. Eury would like to get the group underway no later than October so the group can see sites operating during busy periods
- Group Size - Small group (4-6 people) that will be agile but with redundancy and expertise in harbor management and Beaufort historic preservation
- Length of Travel - Perhaps a two week journey...one week north visiting 5ish select coastal sites and one week south visiting 5ish coastal sites
- Group will gather lessons learned, best practices, and points of contact, and will report back to appropriate Beaufort organizations
- Follow-on virtual sessions will provide a forum for expanded interaction with select sites
- Travel Plan Development - Mr. Eury would like to see the plan in advance
- COVID Restrictions - Recent increase in COVID cases may impact planning and should be a critical go/no go consideration
