Industrial Revenue Bonds, WAM Investments - Phase 2: The purpose of the public hearing is to hear from taxpayers, citizens and other interested parties in regard to the issuance by the City of Bel Aire, Kansas of its Industrial Revenue Bonds (WAM Investments - Phase 2), in a principal amount not to exceed \$3,700,000 (the "Bonds") and in regard to an exemption from ad valorem taxation of property constructed or purchased with the proceeds of such Bonds. The Bonds are proposed to be issued by the Issuer under authority of K.S.A. 12-1740 et seq., as amended, to pay the costs of the acquiring, constructing and equipping of a commercial facility to be located at 9000 E. 46th Street North, Bel Aire, Kansas. The Issuer further intends to lease such facility to WAM Investments, LLC, a Kansas limited liability company, or another legal entity to be formed by the principals of WAM Investments, LLC (the "Tenant").
