Public Hearing IRB Issuance, Waltons 53rd Holdings, LLC: The purpose of the public hearing is to hear from tax payers, citizens, and other stakeholders regarding the issuance by the Issuer of its Taxable Industrial Revenue Bonds (Waltons 53rd Holdings LLC), in a principal amount not to exceed \$12,000,000 (the "Bonds") and in regard to an exemption from ad valorem taxation of property constructed or purchased with the proceeds of such Bonds. The Bonds are proposed to be issued to pay the costs of acquiring, equipping and constructing a 100,000-square-facility to house a meat processing supply and equipment commercial facility located on Lot 8, Block C of the Sunflower Commerce Park Addition (just south of 53rd Street, between Webb Road and Greenwich Road). The Issuer further intends to lease such facility to Waltons 53rd Holdings LLC, a Kansas limited liability company, or a related entity (the "Tenant").
