RE: 4604 Krueger Sewer line repair

Current Situation:

The sewer line at 4604 Krueger has collapsed and needs repaired. The 8" sewer line is almost completely blocked. Staff recommends repairs need to be made as soon as possible. (map on page 2)

Discussion:

Staff reached out to four contractors requesting bids for sewer repairs at this address. Only two of the contractors responded to our request. Their bids are presented below.

Staff reached out to four contractors requesting bids for sidewalk repairs at Eagle Lake. Only one of the contractors responded to our request. Their bids are presented below.




