Town Treasurer/Clerk -Acting Town Manager, Melissa Lewis stated that the Police Chief researched the Dodge Durango due to the New Police Ford Explorer having issues. The Dodge vehicle package is 28,000 and the lighting was the additional \$5,000.00. The Police Chief plans to leave the vehicle unmarked.
