#### **SUMMARY:**

The town has received an allocation of \$10,000 in non-competitive grants from the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS).

#### **BACKGROUND:**

- The Town of Bowling Green Police Department, led by Chief Cecil, secured \$10,000 in non-competitive grant funding from the ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) grant program.
- The grant was obtained through the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice.
- The grant is a 100% reimbursable grant.
- Approved purchases include two rifles (with optics), a vehicle cage to transport arrestees safely, and a new police radio.
- Chief Cecil is currently establishing the necessary accounts to proceed with the purchase of the approved items.

#### **ISSUE:**

### **ALTERNATIVES:**

There are no alternatives; this is a use-or-lose grant.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

The town will expend the funds from the general fund this fiscal year and anticipate grant reimbursement in June 2024 before the close of the fiscal year.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends proceeding with the grant procurement terms and closing out of the grant by the close of the fiscal year.
