2. City Council Meeting

The council thought the charge for the unauthorized removal of a tree in the city was to high. The board disagrees with their decision but lowered the charge to \$50 dollars per inch 4"-24" and \$100 per inch for trees 24" and more. Board discussed lowering it to much would promote the illegal removal and just pay the fine.

On the fee schedules the numbers were consequently changed to match the permit. Chris motioned to approve the changes and Doug seconded. Motion was approved by all the committee.
