Unfinished Business

- Light the Way Updates Reviewed
- **Shirt Updates:** Each committee member will receive a red and a blue shirt. The shirts will include "Special Events Committee" text. The City of Belle Isle logo will not be included on the shirts.
- Santa Ride Updates: Volunteers will be needed to assist with traffic; Stuffed animals will be
 wrapped in cellophane bags for distribution to the children. December 12 and 14 are dates
 selected for Santa rides.
- **Sponsorship and Donations**: Committee members will begin active solicitation of gift cards and funds as well as silent auction items.
