Subject: Discussion of Possible Additional Revenue Sources

Background: Over the past years, the City realized a healthy reserve fund in the General Fund and Storm Water Fund which are the City's two largest funds. However, during this same time, projects were not done; infrastructure was not maintained to a point where it now needs to be replaced. The City prides itself on not raising property taxes for the past 10 years. The City now needs to look to several revenue sources besides property taxes in order to continue to provide the services that residents have come to enjoy and expect from the City, but residents must also realize that they may have to pay to keep these services.

The City staff researched several additional sources of revenue that the Council can discuss and consider if any of these are feasible.

The City staff would like a firm direction from the Council at the conclusion of this Work Session in order to have ample time to prepare the necessary documents so the revenue can be considered for the 2019-20 budget.

Franchise Fees: Franchise fees are paid by utility providers to cities in exchange for operating in the city and using the city's easements and rights-of-way; those fees are ultimately passed down to individual utility customers, who pay a monthly franchise fee charge on their monthly bills. As shown previously, a franchise fee for electrical services could amount to an additional \$375,000/year at 5%. Franchise fees are based on how much the user consumes so it will vary between customers. Franchise fees can also be used for residential garbage services (a 15% franchise fee is placed on commercial accounts in the City). Franchise fees can also be applied to public water and sewer services. The state prohibits the City from placing a franchise fee on telecommunications. The State collects a tax on communications and it is part of the state's revenue sharing. The ordinance can establish that franchise fees are placed in a restricted fund for the maintenance of the streets in the City.

Street/Sidewalk Improvements: The City can charge a right-of-way maintenance fee to every property owner to fund the general maintenance of city streets, street cleaning, traffic signals, and milling and overlaying of streets. This would be a non-ad valorem assessment.

Fire Service fee

MSTU (may be used for emergency services: Fire, police, dispatch)

Local Government Neighborhood Improvement District (Statute 163.506): A LGNID is a dependent special district established to monitor and advocate for the interests of the business and property owners within a defined area. It is intended to foster communication and cooperation among business and property owners. It may also plan for, construct, operate or maintain physical improvements. A LGNID has a staff and an Advisory Council. The Advisory Council develops an operating budget, strategic plan, capital improvements plan and financing plan for review and approval by a Governing Board. A LGNID may levy a special assessment of up to \$500 annually for each individual parcel of land in the district, if approved by referendum. A LGNID may also levy an ad valorem tax on real and personal property of up to 2 mills annually, if approved by referendum.

Review of Non-Ad Valorum assessments: The City staff will review the list of parcels received from the OCPA to determine if any parcels are not being assessed storm water or garbage. Recently we did find one property owner who was not paying storm water assessments for at least 4 years.

Street lighting: Assessment on non-ad valorum for the cost of street lighting

Special Assessments for infrastructure projects (Statute 170.01): Special assessments may be levied only for the purposes enumerated in this section and shall be levied only on benefited real property at a rate of assessment based on the special benefit accruing to such property from such improvements when the improvements funded by the special assessment provide a benefit which is different in type or degree from benefits provided to the community as a whole.


