6 **Section 1.** the City of Belle Isle, FL hereby accepts and approves its designated portion of
7 the Orange County Local Mitigation Strategy.

8 **Section 2.** The staff of Orange County and the City of Belle Isle, FL are requested and
9 instructed to pursue available funding opportunities for implementation of the proposals designated
10 therein.

11 **Section 3.** the City of Belle Isle, FL will, upon receipt of such funding or other necessary
12 resources, seek to implement the proposals contained in its section of the strategy.

13 **Section 4.** the City of Belle Isle, FL will continue to participate in the updating and
14 expansion of the Orange County Local Mitigation Strategy in the years ahead.

15 **Section 5.** the City of Belle Isle, FL will further seek to encourage the businesses, industries
16 and community groups operating within and/or for the benefit of Orange County and the City of Belle
17 Isle, FL to also participate in the updating and expansion of the Orange County Local Mitigation Strategy
18 in the years ahead.

19 **Section 6. Effective Date.** The resolution shall take effect upon the date of its adoption.
