4. Public Hearings

Sec. 42-64. - Variances. The Board shall have the power to approve, conditionally approve or deny applications for a variance from the terms of the Land Development Code.

Criteria. The Board shall not approve an application for a variance from terms of the Land Development Code unless and until:

- a. A written application for a variance is submitted to the city manager or the city manager's designee on a form provided by the city clerk setting forth all of the special conditions and circumstances that exist in favor of the granting of the variance and addressing the requirements of subsections (1)d—g of this section of the criteria set forth in this section. Upon submission of the properly completed application and the appropriate fee, the city manager or the city manager's designee shall refer the application to the board.
- Notice of public hearing for the variance shall be given as required by the article for hearing before the board.
- c. The public hearing on the application for the variance shall be held. The applicant, the applicant's agent as evidenced by a signed writing or the applicant's attorney shall appear before the board.

The City of Belle Isle's Planning and Zoning Board, which comprises seven (7) non-paid volunteer residents, meets on the fourth Tuesday of the month to hear various planning and zoning issues, including variances, special exceptions, and use determinations. In recommending approval or denial of a request, the Board looks at each application individually to determine if the request meets the following criteria:

A written application for a variance must be submitted to City Hall no later than 4:00 p.m. on the first Thursday of the previous month. The application MUST include:

- a. the \$300 filing fee,
- b. a completed application form,
- c. proof of ownership of the property, or a notarized statement from the owner with the representative's information,
- d. Ten (10) copies of a plot plan or survey showing all improvements to the property, ten copies of a scale drawing of the planned construction, illustrated on the survey, and digital format for large-scale documents is required.
- e. For boat dock variances, the survey must clearly illustrate the Normal High Water Line elevation (NHWL) of Lake Conway.
- f. A narrative addressing how the variance complies with the following:

*Standards of Variance Justification	Section 42-64 of the Land Development Code (LDC) states that no application for a Zoning Variance shall be approved unless the Planning and Zoning Board finds that all of the following standards are met. Please answer each bold-text question in a separate typed or a written document and submit it to the City as part of your variance request.

 In granting any variance, the Board may prescribe appropriate conditions and safeguards to comply with the Land Development Code. Violation of such conditions and safeguards, when made a part of the terms under which

- the variance is granted, shall be deemed a violation of this Land Development Code and punishable in accordance with this article. At the Board's discretion, such variance may be revoked for violation of the condition and safeguards.
- b. The Board may prescribe a reasonable time limit within which the action for which the variance is required shall be begun or completed. Under no circumstances, except as permitted above, shall the Board grant a variance to allow a use not generally or by special exception allowed in the zoning district involved, or any use expressly or by implication prohibited by the terms of the Land Development Code in the zoning district. No nonconforming use of neighboring lands, structures, or buildings in the same zoning district, and no permitted use of land, structures, or buildings in other zoning districts, shall be considered grounds for the authorization of a variance.

Applications submitted must meet all of the above criteria before the Board can grant a variance. The burden of proof is on the applicant to comply with the criteria.

A special exception addresses the compatibility of uses, differing slightly from a variance. The approval of a special exception depends on how the request affects the surrounding area. All uses allowed as special exceptions are listed within the individual zoning districts. Before the Board can approve a special exception, the request must meet all of the following criteria:

- A written application for a special exception must be submitted to City Hall no later than 4:00 p.m. on the first Thursday of the previous month. (See Above)
- The Board shall find that it is empowered under the section of the zoning ordinance described in the application to grant the special exception and that granting the special exception will not adversely affect the public interest.
- 3. It is determined that public health, safety, comfort, order, convenience, prosperity, morals, or general welfare is promoted, protected, or improved.

General Information

- 1. Certain conditions may be prescribed on the special exception or variance approved by the Board.
- 2. The applicant must be present at all hearings.
- 3. Decisions rendered by the Board do not become final until fifteen (15) days after the hearing. The fifteen-day waiting period allows all aggrieved parties to appeal the decision. Any person filing an appeal will submit, within fifteen (15) days of the decision, a notice stating where they feel the Planning and Zoning Board erred in their decision. Belle Isle's City Council will then hold an appeal hearing.
- 4. Sec 42-61 thru 41-72 Variances and special exceptions granted by the Board will become void if a permit necessary for utilization of the variance or special exception is not issued within six (6) months of the date approved by the Planning and Zoning Board.

We are requesting a variance for a fence located in the front and side yard of our lot. Our house is on a corner lot with no backyard. We are requesting the variance because we have two dogs whose lives seem positively impacted when they are able to run in the yard, as opposed to us having to walk them on leashes several times a day. We are also hoping to have children in the future and would feel safer if they had a fenced yard to play in. We love our neighborhood and would prefer it if we didn't have to move just to have an enclosed yard.

We have consulted with our neighbors and none of them has expressed any concerns about the fence. The fence is also temporary in nature and can be removed within a few minutes if necessary. If given practically any amount of notice, we would be able to remove the fence if the City needed to access the easement. We would be also be willing to sign a document stating that we would not attempt to hold the City, or any of its contractors, responsible for repairs or reinstallation should the fence need to be removed or be damaged during any work the City was performing.



Sec. 42-64. - Variances. The Board shall have the power to approve, conditionally approve or deny applications for a variance from the terms of the Land Development Code.

Criteria. The Board shall not approve an application for a variance from terms of the Land Development Code unless and until:

- a. A written application for a variance is submitted to the city manager or the city manager's designee on a form provided by the city clerk setting forth all of the special conditions and circumstances that exist in favor of the granting of the variance and addressing the requirements of subsections (1)d—g of this section of the criteria set forth in this section. Upon submission of the properly completed application and the appropriate fee, the city manager or the city manager's designee shall refer the application to the board.
- Notice of public hearing for the variance shall be given as required by the article for hearing before the board.
- c. The public hearing on the application for the variance shall be held. The applicant, the applicant's agent as evidenced by a signed writing or the applicant's attorney shall appear before the board.
- d. It is determined that literal enforcement of the provisions of the zoning ordinances would result in unnecessary hardship and that said hardship is created by special conditions and circumstances peculiar to the land, structure or building involved, including but not limited to dimensions, topography or soil conditions.
- e. It has been determined that personal hardship is not being considered as grounds for a variance since the variance will continue to affect the character of the neighborhood after title to the property has passed and that the special conditions and circumstances were not created in order to circumvent the Land

Development Code or for the purpose of obtaining a variance.

- f. It is determined that the variance is the minimum variance that will make possible the reasonable use of the land, building or structure.
- g. It is determined that the granting of the variance will be in harmony with the general purpose and intent of the Land Development Code, will not be injurious to the neighborhood, will not be detrimental to the public welfare, and will not be contrary to the public interest.
- h. The board shall find that the preceding requirements have been met by the applicant for a variance.

(2) Violations of conditions.

 In granting any variance, the Board may prescribe appropriate conditions and safeguards to comply with the Land Development Code. Violation of such conditions and safeguards, when made a part of the terms under which

- the variance is granted, shall be deemed a violation of this Land Development Code and punishable in accordance with this article. At the Board's discretion, such variance may be revoked for violation of the condition and safeguards.
- b. The Board may prescribe a reasonable time limit within which the action for which the variance is required shall be begun or completed. Under no circumstances, except as permitted above, shall the Board grant a variance to allow a use not generally or by special exception allowed in the zoning district involved, or any use expressly or by implication prohibited by the terms of the Land Development Code in the zoning district. No nonconforming use of neighboring lands, structures, or buildings in the same zoning district, and no permitted use of land, structures, or buildings in other zoning districts, shall be considered grounds for the authorization of a variance.

Applications submitted must meet all of the above criteria before the Board can grant a variance. The burden of proof is on the applicant to comply with the criteria.

A special exception addresses the compatibility of uses, differing slightly from a variance. The approval of a special exception depends on how the request affects the surrounding area. All uses allowed as special exceptions are listed within the individual zoning districts. Before the Board can approve a special exception, the request must meet all of the following criteria:

- A written application for a special exception must be submitted to City Hall no later than 4:00 p.m. on the first Thursday of the previous month. (See Above)
- 2. The Board shall find that it is empowered under the section of the zoning ordinance described in the application to grant the special exception and that granting the special exception will not adversely affect the public interest.
- 3. It is determined that public health, safety, comfort, order, convenience, prosperity, morals, or general welfare is promoted, protected, or improved.

General Information

- 1. Certain conditions may be prescribed on the special exception or variance approved by the Board.
- 2. The applicant must be present at all hearings.
- 3. Decisions rendered by the Board do not become final until fifteen (15) days after the hearing. The fifteen-day waiting period allows all aggrieved parties to appeal the decision. Any person filing an appeal will submit, within fifteen (15) days of the decision, a notice stating where they feel the Planning and Zoning Board erred in their decision. Belle Isle's City Council will then hold an appeal hearing.
- Sec 42-61 thru 41-72 Variances and special exceptions granted by the Board will become void if a permit necessary for utilization
 of the variance or special exception is not issued within six (6) months of the date approved by the Planning and Zoning
 Board.

Special Conditions or Circumstances Section 42-64 (1) d:

The special conditions were brought forth by the high-water table, the environmental department code for my specific size drain field and the home itself being too close to the drain field. My specific drain field is currently the tallest in Belle Isle to my knowledge. It has a very large and difficult to manage slope and as a result of settlement over the past year in a half, the mound slope facing the house and the right side of the mound started showing signs of shifting sand, missing grass, and humps in the front yard closest to the house.

Not Self-Created Section 42-64 (1) e:

The construction of 2411 Nela Ave 32809 was a permitted project with Universal Engineering. The septic system was a part of the permitting process, and the final result is the existing drain field in the front yard in question.

Minimum Possible Variance Section 42-64 (1) f:

I supplied the plans, which are signed and sealed, for a block retaining wall. I modified the measurements to show the measurements for a vinyl fence, NOT ACTING as a retaining wall, but placed at the end of the slope of the drain field. The fence was the minimum variance possible to control future erosion of the slope. The wall was the most aggressive action; any and all bushes or plants would not keep the issue of moving sediment controlled and the larger the plant, tree, or bush, the greater the issues with rooting affecting the field. The space between the fence and the slope was backfilled with topsoil and pea gravel and grass was placed on top.

Purpose and Intent Section 42-64 (1) g:

The addition of this 3-foot fence around the BACK of my very large septic mound poses NO negative effect to my adjacent neighbors or surrounding neighborhood. Quite the contrary, I have provided letters showing overwhelming approval of the fence and new design of plants and bushes in the front of the mound. The fence is in harmony with the home on the property and is mostly hidden from the front view. The purpose of the fence is to create harmony between this beautiful home and the septic field. To assist with a clear and definitive pathway between the house and the field that is safe for both entities. This look was a careful design for this Belle Isle home. The aesthetics and design contribute to the overall curb appeal of the home and property for the community.

I hope that my letter of support for this neighbor's issue as well as other neighbors' letters will help allow the fence to remain for the benefit of our neighborhood and his property.

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




Applicant Request: PURSUANT TO BELLE ISLE CODE SEC. 50-102 (B) (5), SEC. 50-102 (B) (6), SEC. 50-102 (B) (16) AND SEC. 42-64, THE BOARD SHALL CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON A REQUESTED VARIANCE TO PLACE A FENCE IN THE FRONT YARD OF A RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY AND WITHIN A PORTION OF THE CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY, SUBMITTED BY APPLICANT KEVIN KEENEY LOCATED AT 5428 PARKWAY DRIVE, BELLE ISLE, FL 32809 ALSO KNOWN AS PARCEL # 18-23-30-8856-02-100.

Existing Zoning/Use: R-1-AA / Single-Family Residence

Background Information

The applicant was granted a temporary Right-of-Way Utilization Permit to install a nonpermanent fence. The temporary Right-of-Way Utilization Permit expires upon the final decision of this variance request.

Review Comments

This application seeks a variance from Sec. 50-102 (b) (5) (a) to allow a decorative fence in the front yard of the property and a variance from Sec. 50-102 (b) (6) to install a fence within the City right-of-way. The applicant has indicated that this request is for containment of a pet and that there is no backyard. See pictures provided by the property owner enclosed with this agenda item packet.

The board in granting an application for the variance may consider as justifying criteria, the following from Sec. 50-102 (b) (16):

- 1. A difference in grade between the property upon which the fence will be installed and the immediately adjacent property;
- 2. The height or construction materials of already existing abutting walls or fences; and/or
- 3. Conditions existing upon or occupational use of adjacent property creating an exceptional privacy or security need of applicant.

The requirements of Sec. 42-64 (1) except for subsections 42-64 (1) (d) and (1) (f) shall otherwise be met.

Staff Recommendation

Based on the applicant's identification that this variance request is for the containment of pets and future consideration of his family, the variance request cannot be supported by staff. These reasons do not meet the criteria established in Sec. 50-102 (b) (16) (3), which the board may consider as justifying criteria according to the Code. Additionally, private fencing of City rights-of-way is not permitted. There are alternative measures to securing pets as well. Therefore, staff recommends denial of this requested variance application.

Should the board recommend approval for this variance request, staff recommends the applicant file for and record a Right of Way Agreement with the city. Then the applicant must apply for a Right of Way Utilization Permit.

Please note that the Board may approve the proposed variance application as it is presented to them, approve with specific conditions, and continue the application if additional information is being requested for consideration, or deny the application, citing which criteria are not met. Existing Zoning/Use: R-1-AA / Single-Family Residence

Background Information

As of 2021, a new single-family residency was completed at 2411 Nela Avenue. The redevelopment of the land relocated the drain field and septic tank on the property from the rear yard to the front yard. As a result, the construction of the principal building created an elevated earth mound in a portion of the front yard. In December of 2022, a three-sided wall was erected along the perimeter of the earth mound without a permit.

Staff Recommendation

Staff provides an evaluation based on the variance criteria for the application below:

1. Special Conditions and/or Circumstances

The property initially had its drain field and septic tank in the rear, but were relocated approximately two years ago to the front yard to meet building plans for the permitted single-family residency. The certificate of occupancy was issued in 2021. The variance request satisfies the criteria as a special condition.

2. Self-Created

The circumstance of this variance request is self-created as the property owner approved the relocated drain field and septic tank in recent years. The building plans for the SFR permit was approved by the City and Universal Engineering for zoning and building purposes, but the earth mound associated with the land development was left unaddressed until the final product (of the SFR) was complete.

3. Minimum Possible Variance

The applicant examined another option for installing a low front wall, designed specifically to mitigate storm runoff away from the SFR. The front yard wall is three feet tall, meeting the height of the earth mound it was designed to contain.

4. Purpose and Intent

This variance request aims to redirect storm water runoff from channeling towards the principal building. The low vinyl fence is harmonious with the aesthetic of the neighborhood. As of January 13, 2023, no objections or concerns were raised by neighbors.

Staff provides a recommendation to approve the requested variance. The front wall barrier does not exceed its intended use, nor would it drastically alter or deviate from the overall character of the neighborhood.

Staff Report on Artificial Turf Public Opinion Survey

January 24th, 2023

Purpose and Overview of Data Results

In the October 2022 Planning and Zoning meeting, the board members requested city staff gauge the public's opinion on the artificial turf installed among residential properties. The board sought to determine the popularity of artificial turf with the people before establishing zoning regulations in the city code. The artificial turf public opinion survey was developed by the city planner and city manager and then reviewed by other staffers to ensure the questions were understandable to the general public.

The public opinion survey yielded a maximum of 107 responses, and the lowest documented response (on Question #5) yielded 99 responses. Most of the questions are presented on a Likert Scale of 1-5, including a "Neutral" option. The various rating options allow the reader(s) to distinguish between "extreme" opinions, those uncertain, and individuals who lie in-between strong opinions.

Questions #7 and #10 allowed for individualized comments from participants. These comments demonstrate specific concerns about artificial turf on residential lots at the micro and macro level - among individual lots and for the neighborhood overall. The responses for Questions #7 and #10 are listed below. Based on the written responses provided, the most common concerns for allowing artificial turf within the city dealt with the product's environmental impacts (specifically with Lake Conway's water quality, storm runoff, toxic pollutants, and natural preservation).

Direct Comments Provided from the Survey

Q7: Do you have concerns or reservations about allowing artificial turf on individual residential lots? If so, please explain.

- If not properly installed and maintained it becomes an eyesore.
- My perception is that artificial turf is desirable by some because it is "maintenance free"; however, for some people that will become no maintenance ever, thereby creating areal eye sore. Additionally, allowing this is just going to create the need for more municipal oversight and expense for taxpayers.
- This reduces pervious area, creates plastic microbes, encourages mold growth, and creates a huge plastic waste problem.
- Natural grass allows rainwater to drain into the soil. Keeps trees, shrubs, plants healthy. Allows
 rain to drain away instead of pooling on top of artificial turf. Artificial turf should not be allowed
 on residential lots.
- It looks ... cheap and it's not environmentally conscious. Plastic grass? We already have a micro plastic problem.
- My neighbors have artificial grass in their back yard. They have two large dogs that use it to go
 potty on and the ground doesn't absorb it like traditional grass so I get the pleasure of smelling
 it all day.
- Where will the water drain off to? City say significant impact with flooding from hurricane Ian.
- would want it limited i.e. portions of driveways, walkways etc. base surface of artificial turf not permeable
- Impacts environment: creates breeding ground for cockroaches, inhibits birds from eating bugs/grubs/and the like. Does not allow soil underneath to gain nutrients it needs for sustainability, trees, etc... The turf will act as a solarization blanket killing the 'good' bugs and organisms for healthy soil. Turf gets worn and can look like a used old carpet with patches of wear - this is not a good look for neighborhood and market
- Artificial turf is just that...Artificial. It is composed of toxic chemicals, which over time leach into
 our environment. We already have so many pollutants in our soils and lakes. Allowing artificial
 turf will exponentially increase the toxic load of our environment. It is NOT a good idea.
- AT doesn't seem the best for healthy lakes.
- They do not hold up well to dog and cat pee the edges turnup after a year or two and good turf
 is very expensive
- No problems with Belle isle grasses.
- Several environmental concerns loss of animal habitat and synthetic materials
- Environmental impacts, drainage, unsightly (plastic and fake looking), How will it stand up to
 hurricane winds and torrential rains, rain runoff affects neighbors, Does not absorb CO2
 emissions and cannot produce oxygen, it must harbor bacteria when dogs/animals poop and
 pee on it...ugh. This is not being good stewards of our environment. Our increased emissions
 associated with more people living here and driving and then putting in artificial turf that cannot
 help mitigate the emissions effects and may even make it worse. Water filtration before it gets

to the lakes would not happen on a plastic turf with hard compacted soil that does not absorb rain. Therefore, all the chemicals will go directly into the lake. How does the AT hold up to the sun and when it breaks down, will it put harmful chemicals into the lakes, atmosphere, and soil? It is made of plastic, some of which are known carcinogens and others may be found out to be at a later date. Natural turf is not cancerous and will not create gases that are harmful. Those with AT will be blaming you when the next hurricane comes and they flood because the water did not drain. This really cannot be a good idea. It is as bad as letting someone concrete their yard. You let one person then everyone will want to do it because of low maintenance and it stays green. Think of the problems when a whole neighborhood goes that direction.

- There are several environmental concerns associated with artificial turf including loss of wildlife
 habitat, contaminated runoff and migration of synthetic materials. Contaminants that are
 harmful to aquatic life, such as zinc, have been found in storm water runoff from artificial turf.
 Because natural materials such as grass absorb carbon dioxide during photosynthesis, replacing
 them with artificial grass also directly contributes to the increase of carbon dioxide (a primary
 greenhouse gas) in the atmosphere.
- Not appropriate-this is not a golf course. No way artificial turf is as eco-friendly as organic materials. My neighbor has artificial turf and it's an eye sore.
- should be like concrete and only allow a percentage
- Cheap, poorly maintained artificial turn looks terrible. Also, need to make sure it doesn't impact drainage.
- Maybe for front yard approval should be considered, I; however, I do not see a reason for well manicured backyards.
- That it be kept clean and free of debris
- It's better than using chemicals to maintain grass.
- Should only be allowed in back yards, less then 25% of total back yard, due to drainage issues the turf will cause.
- Recent street flooding from lan shows we don't need more run-off.
- 1. Artificial turf will create serious problems for OC landfill. Life is only 8 years. It will prevent rainwater replenishing the aquifer., to subsurface are problematical. Unsightly and a difficult issue for code enforcement. AT was intended for football fields where there are sufficient funds to maintain it.
- I'm concerned about how it would look if it was not properly maintained (rips, tears, weathering, etc.)
- Belle Isle is an ecological paradise where humans, homes, and wildlife thrive because of our landscapes and lakes. Artificial turf can disrupt our local ecology which manages to thrive despite heavy development.
- There is no section to elaborate on support of artificial turf, so I will use this portion of the survey. While artificial turf is not the optimal selection in all landscape instances, there are many scenarios where it is the superlative choice (ie: low light or covered areas, as an option to other hardscape materials for foot traffic areas, pool decks, patio extensions, etc.). Also, please note

that question 8 is not exclusive of artificial turf... Florida Friendly plant selections can be complimented with the use of artificial turf.

- My only concern is what will it looks like in time.
- Can't imagine what it would look like after a few years
- Belle Isle is known for its natural beauty. Beautiful lakes, large lots, huge trees, and wildlife. We
 are a bird sanctuary. We just had flooding and it could interfere with absorption of water into
 the ground. While it does not need to be mowed, it still has to be maintained.
- In my opinion, it would look too different than other neighboring lots and would take away from the aesthetics of the neighborhood. Another issue would be landscaping and mowing your own yard when that is next to your property line.




Overview: Based on the interviews, there is a relatively low and steady demand for artificial turf among residential properties. The Code Enforcement department among the Florida municipalities typically oversees the final implementation and maintenance of the synthetic product after its installment, and issues citations if not secured and preserved. Each respondent cited historical and environmental issues regarding artificial turf for its impact on the community's permitting process, neighborhood aesthetic, allowable impervious area for a singular lot, and residential landscaping options. An artificial turf ordinance was driven by "the people" and complaints were filed against unpermitted or unkept artificial turf installations.

Q1 Have you considered installing artificial turf on your property?







Q3 Should City Code allow for artificial turf on residential lots?





Q4 Should only a percentage of the property be allowed to have artificial turf?












