1. Call to Order – 1 min

Mayor James called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm.

2. Approval of Agenda – 1 min

C. Town Council Closed Session Minutes | February 10, 2025

Mayor James called for a motion to approve the February 10, 2025, closed session minutes. CM Dixon moved the motion, and CM McBryde seconded it. The motion passed unanimously, 5-0.

4. Presentations

- A. FY 2026 Budget
- 4. Town Administrator Bailey-Hedgepeth presented the FY 2026 Budget. Topics covered included revenue estimates, constant yield tax rates, and updates on residential, commercial, and

apartment tax assessments, which increased by 7% and 1%, respectively. The budget for the July 4th fireworks event was reviewed, as well as budgets for various town events, including food vendor pricing and logistics for the Turkey Distribution event. Council budget details were also discussed, with an emphasis on a 17% increase in health insurance costs. Employee recognition events, scholarships for local students, community grant programs, membership fees for various organizations, and funding for senior community were also covered.
