 - Dominion Energy Hardeeville to Bluffton Rebuild (Public Project): A request by Matt Jennings of W.K. Dickson & Co., Inc. on behalf of Matt Talley of Dominion Energy for the approval of a Public Project. Dominion Energy proposes to rebuild an existing electric transmission line from Hardeeville into the Town of Bluffton. The proposed project will consist of the construction of new steel monopole overhead electric structures and the removal of old wooden poles along Dominion Energy's existing right-of-way. The project corridor traverses multiple parcels, extending approximately 10.2 miles within the Town of Bluffton limits. (DP-03-23-017750) (Staff – Dan Frazier)
 - Rotary Center Enhancements (Public Project): A request by Pat Rooney on behalf of the Town of Bluffton for approval of a Public Project. The project consists of the construction of tabby sidewalks, a pervious paver seating area, golf cart parking, a rain garden, landscaping and site furnishings within Oscar Frazier Park. The property is zoned Schultz Planned Unit Development and consists of approximately 34.7 acres identified by tax map number R610 039 000 0427 0000 located at 7 Recreation Court within the Bluffton Park Master Plan.
