VI. NEW BUSINESS

- 1. Certificate of Appropriateness (95 Green Street):** A request by Glenda Mikulak Roberts, Applicant and Owner, for review of a Certificate of Appropriateness-HD to construct a new 1.5-story house of approximately 2,342 SF at 95 Green Street in Old Town Bluffton Historic District and zoned Neighborhood General-HD. (COFA-08-24-019275)(Staff-Charlotte Moore)

Staff presented. The applicant was present. The commissioners discussed the home's height relative to nearby properties and raised concerns about tree preservation, requesting clarification on the site plan's protection measures. They also reviewed the chimney cap visibility, wall section details, shutter consistency between the existing and proposed structures, and the vertical divisions in the door sidelites.

Commissioner Hess made a motion to approve the application with the following conditions:

1. Remove the gate from the utility meter screening fence or, alternatively, provide landscaping to screen the meter.
2. Rotate the chimney cap to not be visible from the street.

3. Provide the source and type of brick proposed to be used for approval by Town staff.
4. Provide a rear elevation door that is wood, metal or metal-clad.
5. Headers on the porches are to be consistent.
6. Band boards on the porches are to be consistent.
7. Remove the vertical divides in the door sidelites.
8. Consistent with UDO Sec. 5.15.6.J., provide the roof material.

and the following was determined to be appropriate:

1. The massing of the middle block
