BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Article IV of the City of Breckenridge Code of Ordinances provides for the guidance of elections of the governing body election. Additionally, state statute sets the first Saturday in May as a uniform election date. This year's election day was held on May 2, 2026.

This year, three citizens were to be elected at-large to serve a two-year term as Mayor and Commissioner Place 1 and Commissioner Place 2. The incumbents for these positions were Bob Sims, Blake Hamilton, and Greg Akers

There was a total of 398 ballots cast. The tentative results of this election are as follows:

RESOLUTION CANVASSING ELECTION RETURNS FOR THE CITY OF BRECKENRIDGE, TEXAS GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON SATURDAY, MAY 2, 2026 FOR MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSIONER PLACES NO. 1 AND 2.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of said City ordered an election to be held in said City on May 2, 2026, for MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSIONER PLACES NO. 1 AND 2; and

WHEREAS, said City Commission has investigated all matters pertaining to said election, including the ordering, giving notice, officers, holding and making returns of said election; and

WHEREAS, the election officers who held said election have duly made the returns of the result thereof, and said returns have been duly delivered to said City Commission.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF BRECKENRIDGE:

1. That the City Commission officially finds and determines that said election was duly ordered, that proper notice of said election was duly given, that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said election, that said election was duly held, that due returns of the result of said election have been made and delivered, and that the City Commission has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with law and the Ordinance calling said election.

2. That the City Commission officially finds and determines that the following votes were cast at said election, MAYOR, AND CITY COMMISSIONER PLACES NO. 1 AND 2, by the residents, qualified electors of said City, who voted at the election:

FOR MAYOR
126 VOTES: BOB SIMS
24 VOTES: BRENT ENSEY
73 VOTES : PAUL HUNTINGTON JR.
172 VOTES: KORD TRAMMEL

FOR COMMISSIONER PLACE 1
260 VOTES: BLAKE HAMILTON
125 VOTES: JOHN GREEN

FOR COMMISSIONER PLACE 2
345 VOTES: JUSTIN ROSE

3. That the City Commission officially finds, determines and declares the result of said election to be for MAYOR **Kord Trammell** has received a majority vote of 172; for CITY COMMISSIONER PLACE NO. 1 **Blake Hamilton** has received a majority vote of **260**; for CITY COMMISSIONER PLACE NO. 2 **Justin rose** has received a majority vote of **345**; there being cast a total of **398** votes at said election.
