New Business

The commission approved the minutes from the February 16, 2022 meeting. Motion by John Guardado. Seconded by Beth Savage.

Franchise Fees

Franchise fee were down about 2% from last quarter.

Customer Complaints

There were low hanging wires reported at 10077 Barr Rd. AT&T technical support was called on 2/11/22. The repair was completed within 7 business days.

Open Forum

There was open discussion regarding the new AT&T plan for installing a Fiber Optic Expansion Network in Brecksville and how it will effect residents and franchise fees for the city. There was discussion about the rezoning of the two properties in Brecksville that will be on the May 3rd ballot. The approval of Issue 2 would rezone the 1.750 acres at the corner of Chippewa and Wiese Roads from a single family district to an office district. The approval of Issue 3 would rezone the 1 acre parcel on Highland Drive (the previous Center for the Arts Bldg.) from a single family district to a community facilities district. There was a discussion about the usage of the old Central School property. Also there was discussion about sidewalks on Oakes Road leading to the new Elementary School and how it will impact the community financially and connectively.

With no further business to discuss the meeting adjourned at 7:05 p.m. Motion to adjourn by Jennifer Elting. Seconded by Beth Savage.


Meetings for the remainder of 2022 were tentatively discussed for September and November 2022.
