WOODLANDS OF SNOWVILLE PHASE 3 – Preliminary Approval Extension Request – 0000 Snowville Rd.

Travis Crane, on behalf of Chris Schmidt of the Davey Resource Group, presented a request on behalf of the applicant, Snowville Joint Venture, for an extension of the March, 2023 Preliminary Approval for Woodlands of Snowville Phase 3 due to current market conditions.

Mr. Wise reported that the Group is actively working on Phase 2 of the project and making progress. He sees no items of concern.

HIGHLAND DRIVE MAJOR SUBDIVISION TREE FELLING ONLY – 9457 Highland Dr.

Hanna Cohan Plessner, Tribal Investment, LLC, presented the request for final approval for tree felling only at the Highland Drive Subdivision. She is requesting this final approval at the site to complete this activity by March 31, 2024, at which time tree clearing activities are restricted due to endangered or threatened species.

Mr. Wise reported that she has worked closely with the City Arborist, Joe Dwyer, on site and reviewed their application. Mr. Dwyer issued an approval letter with the requirements outlined.

Mr. Wise also reported that the EPA application has been completed and the company is aware of the wetlands area of the property that must be protected.

Mr. Lahrmer asked for any additional comments/questions from the Commission. There were none.

PROPOSED PLANNING & ZONING CODE AMENDMENT – Adult Use Cannabis Activity Prohibition in All Use Districts

Monica Bartkiewicz presented to the Commission a referral from City Council proposing an amendment to the Planning & Zoning Code to prohibit adult use cannabis activities in all zoning districts. They are seeking the Planning Commission's report and recommendation on this issue.
