AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 145.13 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE AND THE EXEMPTED EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF BRECKSVILLE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brecksville,
County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. Section 145.13 of the Administrative Code be amended to read
as follows:

“145.13 EXEMPTED EMPLOYEES.

The following job titles are hereby declared to be executive,
administrative or professional positions and the persons employed
therein shall not be entitled to overtime pay provided in Section
145.08 or compensatory time off, although they shall be entitled to all
other benefits accorded full-time employees of the municipality by
this Chapter. In fixing the annual compensation for the positions
listed herein, Council shall give due consideration to the
responsibilities of each job and the duties and obligations such job
imposes upon the employee.

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

The Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is the need to add/remove certain positions from the list of exempted employees, therefore, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.



ASSOCIATES AS CONSULTING ENGINEERS AND
GERALD M. WISE AS THE CITY ENGINEER;
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, at its meeting of March 2, 2010, the Council approved Ordinance No. 4550, retaining the services of Donald G. Bohning & Associates as consulting engineers with an approved rate schedule and designating Gerald M. Wise as the City Engineer; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of January 2, 2012, the Council approved Ordinance No. 4665, amending Ordinance No. 4550 to provide a new rate schedule for the services of Donald G. Bohning & Associates; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of January 2, 2013, the Council approved Ordinance No. 4741, amending Ordinance Nos. 4550 and 4665 to provide a new rate schedule for the services of Donald G. Bohning & Associates; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of January 2, 2014, the Council approved Ordinance No. 4816, amending Ordinance Nos. 4550, 4665, and 4741 to provide a new rate schedule for the services of Donald G. Bohning & Associates; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of December 1, 2015, the Council approved Ordinance No. 4967, amending Ordinance Nos. 4550, 4665, 4741 and 4816 to provide a new rate schedule for the services of Donald G. Bohning & Associates; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of September 21, 2021, the Council approved Ordinance No. 5434, amending Ordinance Nos. 4550, 4665, 4741 and 4816, 4967, 5142 and 5276 to provide a new rate schedule for the services of Donald G. Bohning & Associates; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to amend the current retainer and rate schedule for the services of Donald G. Bohning & Associates.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4550, Section 3, be amended as follows:

“SECTION 3. For the services described in Section 2 of this Ordinance, the Engineer shall be paid an annual amount of ~~\$71,940.00 for the year 2022 and \$71,940.00 for the year 2023~~ **\$71,940.00 for the year 2024 and \$71,940.00 for the year 2025** to be divided into twelve equal payments to be invoiced by Donald G. Bohning & Associates, Inc., in conjunction with additional compensation as further provided for in this Ordinance. For

attendance at any requested Special Council or Council Committee Meetings, other than meetings of the Utilities Committee, beyond six per year, the Engineer shall be paid per the rate schedule in Section 8 of this Ordinance. Likewise, for any field survey work or Engineering drawings required for the submitted for any Grant and Funding Applications, the Engineer shall be paid as provided in Section 8 of this Ordinance.”

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 4550, Section 8, Ordinance No. 4665, Section 2, Ordinance No. 4741, Section 2, Ordinance No. 4816, Section 2, Ordinance No. 4967, Section 2, Ordinance No. 5142, Section 2, and Ordinance No. 5276, Section 2. be amended as follows:

“SECTION 8. That for such Services as the Engineer shall be requested to render, the City shall pay upon detailed invoicing, according to the following rates:

SECTION 3. All other provisions of Ordinance No. 4550 except Sections 3. and 8. as amended by this Ordinance, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. The Council hereby appropriates sufficient funds to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to transfer the funds necessary to complete this expenditure from the available funds of the City. The Director of Finance be and is hereby further authorized to issue the fiscal officer’s certificate necessary to make the expenditures as described in Section 1 hereof, and is further directed to issue vouchers of this City in the amounts and for the purposes expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the appropriately designated Fund.

The Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is that it relates to the daily operation of a municipal department, therefore, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect

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
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



AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF VARIOUS GRADES OF GASOLINE AND DIESEL FUEL FOR THE CITY OF BRECKSVILLE THROUGH A JOINT MUNICIPAL PURCHASING CONSORTIUM; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Brecksville is authorized to purchase various grades of gasoline and diesel fuel through its membership in a Joint Municipal Purchasing Consortium at a lower rate than if it purchased it on the open market; and

WHEREAS, the bids submitted to the Joint Municipal Purchasing Consortium were consistent with the competitive bidding requirements of the Ohio Revised Code and the Charter of the City of Brecksville.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The bids of Ports Petroleum Co., Inc. and Petroleum Traders Corporation dated October 31, 2023 for the purchase of various grades of gasoline and diesel fuel for the City of Brecksville in various amounts as stated in their bid submissions, for a one year period with an option to renew for an additional one year period at the discretion of the City, in accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the Director of Purchasing, be and the same hereby are, accepted.


SECTION 2. The Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into contracts on behalf of the City of Brecksville with Ports Petroleum Co., Inc. and Petroleum Traders Corporation for a term from January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024, as set forth in Section 1 hereof, said contracts to be in such form as is approved by the Director of Law.

SECTION 3. The Council hereby appropriates sufficient funds to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to transfer the funds necessary to complete this expenditure from the available funds of the City. The Director of Finance be and is hereby further authorized to issue the fiscal officer's certificate necessary to make the expenditures as described in Section 1 hereof, and is further directed to issue vouchers of this City in the amounts and for the purposes expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the appropriately designated Fund.


