A. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Chair Van Alstine called the meeting to order at 5:03 p.m.

D. REGULAR ITEMS

1. Discuss and consider approval of the November 14, 2023 meeting minutes.

Motion made by Committee Member Arens, seconded by Committee Member Stenovitch to approve the November 14, 2023 meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

2. Discussion of Memorial Day Celebration.

The Committee considered the date of the celebration and decided on Monday May 27th. Advertising for the event was discussed as were decorations & activities. A car show, carnival games, bounce houses, and a live band and dance floor were all considered. The Committee discussed asking local restaurants to donate food for the event. A farmers market and cooking competition were also considered. It was determined that there would be a veteran's appreciation at the event, and the possibility of including boy scouts and JROTC members was considered.

3. Discussion of Town time capsule.

The Committee discussed which items to include in the time capsule. A t-shirt and pictures from the 50th Anniversary Celebration were considered, as well as older pictures and a copy of the Town land use plan. It was decided that the time capsule would be established at the Memorial Day Celebration and would be housed permanently at Town Hall.

4. Discussion of Christmas Tree Celebration for 2024.

The location and date of the celebration were discussed, and an area next to Town Hall was found to be most favorable. Deputy Town Secretary Carpenter informed the Committee that the proposed area is owned primarily by a private property owner and not the Town, and proposed an agreement with said property owner which would allow the Town to hold the event at that location. The Committee discussed having the tree set-up take place November 23rd or 24th, and the Celebration take place December 1st. It was decided that the current size of the tree is sufficient, and no additional parts need to be purchased at this time.
