Bartonville Police Sergeant Scudder discussed traffic control measures, including blocking Jeter Rd., placing officers on either side of the blockade, and posting detour signs. The Committee determined that the number of panel discussions would be reduced from two to one. Food, invitations, & T-shirts were confirmed, and it was decided that the time capsule would be put together after the event.

3. Discussion of Christmas Tree Lighting Celebration.

The Committee noted that the tree had been delivered & was currently in storage at a private residence. Transportation of the tree to the event site was discussed, as was doing a trial run of the set-up.

4. Discussion of the 2024 Memorial Day Celebration.

There was no discussion of the 2024 Memorial Day Celebration, as the meeting time was limited to one hour due to scheduling restraints. It was discussed that the next meeting would take place October 23, 2024, at 5:00 p.m.

Randy Van Alstine adjourned the meeting at 6:00 p.m.


