The Bartonville Traffic Committee held a meeting on the 22nd day of May, 2023, at 6:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers of Bartonville Town Hall, 1941 East Jeter Road, Bartonville, Texas.

There constituting a quorum, the following business took place:

A. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Carrington called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

B. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE AMERICAN FLAG

Mayor Carrington led the Pledge of Allegiance.

C. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

There was none.

D. ITEMS

1. Consider approval of October 11, 2022, meeting minutes.

<u>Council Member Crandall moved to approve the minutes.</u> Council Member Sams seconded the motion. The motion carried by a vote of 4 to 0.

2. Discuss and consider recommendations to the Town Council regarding traffic safety measures and cost estimates.

Cassidy McCollum spoke of speeding, increased traffic, and accidents at the intersection of Porter Road and Rockgate Road.

Staff presented options for installation of stop signs on northbound and southbound Porter Road, including the addition of rumble strips, a "stop ahead" sign traveling southbound, and the relocation of signs that could negatively impact attention to the stop signs.

Council Member Sams moved to recommend to Town Council the addition of stop signs on northbound and southbound Porter Road, and the include those other measures recommended by staff, and to amend the Town's budget by \$2,720 to complete the work. Member Van Alstine seconded the motion. The motion carried by a vote of 4 to 0.
