BUDGET STATEMENT

Pursuant to Section 551.043, Government Code, the following taxpayer impact statement must be on the City Council meeting agenda at which the City Council will discuss or adopt a budget for the City of Burleson: For a median-valued homestead property (\$301,997 for tax year 2025, \$297,979 for tax year 2026), the City's portion of the property tax bill in dollars for the current fiscal year (FY25-26) is \$2,180, the City's portion of the property tax bill for the upcoming fiscal year (FY26-27) for the same property if the proposed budget is adopted is estimated to be \$2,151, and the City's portion of the property tax bill in dollars for the upcoming fiscal year (FY26-27) for the same property if a budget funded at the no-new-revenue rate under Chapter 26, Tax Code, is adopted is estimated to be \$2,209. A copy of the proposed budget is accessible on the home page of the governmental body's Internet website (www.burlesontx.com).

*The figures used in the statement above are based on estimates available to the City as of the date of posting. At this time the City has received estimated, not certified, tax rolls from the Johnson County Central Appraisal District. Additionally, the City has not received the calculation of relevant tax rates under Chapter 26, Tax Code. Further, as of the date of posting, the city manager has not filed the proposed budget with the city secretary. The city manager anticipates filing the proposed budget on Monday, August 3, 2026.
