


Pedestrian Improvements - BHS

Background

•Staff received a request from a resident in October regarding students parking along Sunnybrook Drive and crossing over the drainage channel to access Burleson High School.





Background

- •Staff met with BISD staff in November to discuss the possibility of a bridge and sidewalk to help mitigate the hazard of students crossing the ditch, especially during wet weather when the drainage channel is full and water is moving swiftly.
- •Initial feedback from BISD staff was the concern of encouraging pedestrian mobility from Sunnybrook to behind the field house where there is limited visibility.
- •Initial recommendation from BISD staff was to fence off the access to mitigate the risk.




Pedestrian Improvements – Pleasant Manor

Background


- Staff received a concern from a resident in October regarding overgrown vegetation at the bridge adjacent to Crossroads Learning Center
- •Staff responded and cleaned up the bridge and regraded the approach to the bridge
- •Also included in the concern was the lack of sidewalk/trail between the bridge and Pleasant Manor
- •Staff discussed possible cost sharing with BISD, but they were not in favor since it is not on their property




- •Initial plan called for Pleasant Manor Ave to extend over the creek
- Approved plan included a pedestrian bridge and a future sidewalk to be constructed by the city

Discussion



- Existing fee simple
- •Staff would recommend constructing sidewalk to Lynnewood Ave.
- •Approx 500' of 6' wide sidewalk
- •Estimated Design and Construction cost \$100,000
