**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors ("Board") of the Type A Corporation has reviewed the proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference for all purposes (the "Budget"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Board desires to approve the Budget, and finds the Budget will further the purposes of the Type A Corporation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF THE BURLESON 4A ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION THAT:

#### Section 1

The Budget attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes is adopted for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2024, and ending September 30, 2025; and there is hereby appropriated from the funds indicated such projects, operations, activities, purchases and other expenditures as proposed in the Budget.

#### Section 2

As described in the attached Budget, the Type A Corporation authorizes the transfer or expenditure of \$10,976,718 in Type A sales tax revenue in FY 24-25 for the following purposes set forth in the Budget.

#### Section 3

The Type A Corporation respectfully requests that the City Council ratify this resolution.

#### Section 4

The Secretary of the Type A Corporation is hereby directed to publish notice of this action following ratification by City Council as required by law.
