WHEREAS, the City has lost a valued member of its community with the death of Kathryne Stern; and

WHEREAS, Kathryne Hattie Stern was born on January 22, 1949, to Oma Lee and Mary Patton in Fayetteville, Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Kathryne was a woman of deep faith who dedicated her life to the Lord at Light of the World Missionary Baptist Church at a young age, and she remained actively involved in her church communities throughout her life; and

WHEREAS, Kathryne was a talented artist proficient in drawing and ceramics for which she received a scholarship to study at a college in California; and

WHEREAS, Kathryne’s artistic talents and flair were complemented by her impeccable, classy and celebrated sense of fashion; and

WHEREAS, Kathryne also attended Chicago Community College and was a jack of all trades working at AT&T, Wonder Bread, and as a manger at the Super K-Mart Bakery; and

WHEREAS, Kathryne also gained experience as a welder at Thrall-Carr in Chicago Heights where she met Darren Stern in 1979; and

WHEREAS, Kathryne and Darren were married in 1980 in Chicago and shared forty-six beautiful and wonderful years together; and

WHEREAS, Kathyne was deeply involved and engaged in her community serving as both the Vice President and President of the Calumet City School Board in addition to volunteering and campaigning with former Mayor Michelle Markiewicz Qualkinbush where she helped secure a winning ballot ticket; and

WHEREAS, Kathyne also greatly enjoyed reading, solving puzzles, cooking, and spending time with her biological children, adopted children and grandchildren; and

WHEREEAS, Kathyne is preceded in death by her parents Oma Lee and Mary, her siblings Ulysses, Mary, and Maggie Patton, her daughter Laverne Chandler, and her nephew Demetrius; and

WHEREAS, Kathyne is survived and remembered by her husband Darren, her daughters Lisa and Brittini, her sons Wiley and Darren II, her godson Samuel, her brother Barry, her grandchildren Kathyne, Dennaë, Jachai, Acacia, Jeremiah, Zaire, Synseer, Darren III, and Erran, her greatgrandchild Miracle, and all the neighborhood children whose lives she positively impacted; and

WHEREAS, Kathyne will always be remembered for her generous and loving spirit and the way she made everyone she interacted with feel welcome in her home; and

WHEREAS, Kathyne was a beloved daughter, wife, mother, friend, prayer warrior and mentor whose memory will live on in the hearts of all those who love and treasure her memory; and

WHEREAS, the death of Kathyne has left the City and the community deeply saddened.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Calumet City hereby extend our sincerest condolences to Kathyne Stern's family and friends, and

extend our sincere gratitude for Kathryne’s contributions to the City and her impact, life and legacy.

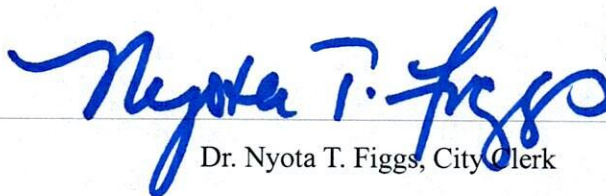
