INTRODUCTION/PURPOSE/SUMMARY: This is phase II of the Lacamas Shores Sewer Lift Station project. This work is for electrical and controls upgrades. Staff had solicited bids from all contractors on our small works roster and received only one bid from Hamer Electric Inc. The bid amount is over the engineers estimate by \$5,638.50 or 3%. Staff believes this is reasonable and recommends Council approval.
