**BACKGROUND:** Additional work has been added to the scope of the NE 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue Street Improvements project.

**SUMMARY:** Advanced Excavation Services (AES) is currently constructing the NE 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue Improvements project located on the south side of Safeway between NE Everett and NE Garfield Streets. The approved plans include installation of new water service lines to replace the existing galvanized steel services connected to an old steel water main. After reviewing conditions and discussing further with Operations, the project team has directed AES to completely abandon the steel water main in NE 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave. (from Dallas Street to Garfield Street), relocate all water service lines onto an existing larger, newer parallel water main and replace five additional water services and two fire hydrants that were not included in the original project scope. The estimated cost of the added work, including additional improved roadway surfacing will be approximately \$64,000, or roughly 16% of the original project cost. There is Water Fund repair and replacement money included in the 2022 adopted Budget that will be used to complete this additional work. AES has already started the work; however, as this change order exceeds 10% of the awarded bid amount, staff will be bringing it forward to Council for concurrence at the July 5, 2022, meetings.

#### **NOTES:**

- **1A** –Grinding and hauling of asphalt pavement to accommodate lengthened water service connections.
- **1B** Grading operations to construct additional asphalt pavement.
- **1C** Decrease quantity in Bid Item 37 from 9 to 1. Increase unit cost to construct water service connection due to increased pipe length.
- **1D** Increase quantity in Bid Item 38 from 1 to 13. Increase unit cost to construct water service connection due to increased pipe length.
- **1E** Asphalt trench resurfacing for additional water services.
- **1F** Disconnect old water main from the City water system and abandon in place.
- **1G** Connect the new fire hydrant to the existing water main.
- **1H** Add two new fire hydrants and associated pipe, valves and fittings.
- **1I** Remove an unmarked abandoned gas pipe that will interfere with roadway improvements.
- 1J Additional traffic control to accommodate the extended work duration.

**1K** – Decrease unit cost to construct water service connection due to decreased pipe length.

The scope of the water system improvements was increased per request of the Public Works Operations division after the project was awarded to the contractor. Scope revisions include connecting water services to an 8-inch cast iron water main instead of a 6-inch steel water main that is closer to the water meter, replacement of five additional water services, abandonment of a 6-inch steel water main and replacement of two fire hydrants. Additional work related to the water system modifications include reconstruction of additional asphalt pavement, asphalt trench resurfacing for the additional water services, removal of an unmarked abandoned gas line and traffic control for the period required to perform the additional work. These change order revisions eliminate the need for three bid items, which are being deleted from the scope of the project. All work in this change order will be funded by the City Water Repair and Replacement Fund and was included in the 2022 adopted City budget.

The amount of the contract will be <u>increased</u> by the sum of: <u>Sixty four thousand two hundred eighty seven</u> and <u>17/100 Dollars</u> (\$64,287.17)

The contract total, including the original contract total, this and previous change orders will be <u>increased</u> to Four hundred seventy eight thousand two hundred seventy two and 83/100 Dollars (\$478,272.83)

The contract period provided for completion will be <u>increased</u> by seven days.

This document will become a supplement to the contract and all provisions will apply hereto.

**SUMMARY:** With the changes to the Open Public Meetings Act (OPMA) under ESHB 1329 now in effect, the Camas Municipal Code (CMC) needs to be changed to reflect the new law.

While under OPMA, meetings must have a physical location for the public to attend, the law now expressly allows members of a governing body to attend meetings remotely. A governing body as defined in the OPMA, is any multimember board, commission, committee, council, or other policy or rule-making body of a public agency. As such, these code changes apply to all the City's meeting bodies that meet these criteria. This will allow their members to participate remotely.

This change does not apply to attendance in Executive Sessions. Given the strict laws surrounding the confidentiality of Executive Sessions, the updates state that they be attended in person, while permitting remote participation on a case-by-case basis. The remote participation is allowable only if City Council considers a member's participation necessary and is confident in the security of that member's remote communication.

### ORDINANCE NO. 22-\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE amending Section 2.04.040 of the Camas Municipal Code relating to remote meeting attendance.

## THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

#### Section I

A new Subsection 2.04.040 (C)(4) is added to the Camas Municipal Code to provide as follows:

(C)(4) Remote attendance for any other reason would be considered as an alternative and relatively infrequently used method for participation, subject to the Council member providing sufficient advance notice and prior approval by the Mayor and further subject to the Council member demonstrating that satisfactory equipment will be available for their participation as required herein.

## Section II

A new Subsection 2.04.040 (F) is hereby added to the Camas Municipal Code to provide as follows:

(F) All executive sessions shall be attended in person by a Council Member. The Council may permit participation from remote locations only when the Council, on a case-by-case base, considers such participation as necessary, and the Council is confident in the security of such remote communication.

### ORDINANCE NO. 22-\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE amending certain provisions of the Camas Municipal Code relating to City commission meetings

### THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

#### Section I

Camas Municipal Code Section 2.28.040 is hereby amended to provide as follows:

## Camas Municipal Code 2.28.040 - Officers—Quorum—Regular meetings

The parks and recreation commission shall annually elect a chairperson and vice chairperson to preside at its meeting. Four members of the commission shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, and a majority of the commission shall be required to approve any action. The parks and recreation commission shall have a regular monthly meeting on the fourth Wednesday of each month at five p.m. at City Hall or by remote attendance via audio or video conferencing as may be allowed by law and under the circumstances as set forth within Camas Municipal Code Section 2.04.040C. Remote attendance by commission members shall be announced by the Chairperson, or Vice Chairperson in the absence of the Chairperson, and be reflected in the meeting minutes. Remote attendance shall further be subject to the conditions as set forth within Section 2.04.040D.

#### Section II

Camas Municipal Code Section 2.32.060 is hereby amended to provide as follows:

## **Camas Municipal Code 2.32.060 – Meetings**

The planning commission shall meet on the third Tuesday of each month at the hour of seven p.m., which meetings shall be held at City Hall of Camas, Washington or by remote attendance via audio or video conferencing as may be allowed by law and under the circumstances as set forth within Camas Municipal Code Section 2.04.040C. Remote attendance by commission members shall be announced by the Chairperson and be reflected in the meeting minutes. Remote attendance shall further be subject to the conditions as set forth within Section 2.04.040D. Special meetings may be called by the chairman of the planning commission upon due notice to all members of the commission and upon compliance with the notice requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act, RCW Chapter 42.30.

# HOMELESSNESS STRATEGIES

Council Discussion

## WHAT WE KNOW

- Homelessness is a national crisis.
- Camas has homeless individuals and families at all levels.
- Roughly 8% of our total homeless community are from outside the Camas/Washougal area. Most have family or community connections here.

## WHAT WE WANT

- COUNCIL VALUES
- All community members feel supported within Camas city limits.
- Homelessness is not a crime and individuals shall be treated with respect, dignity, and compassion and strive to minimize harm and trauma.
- There is nothing compassionate about letting people sleep in a tent.
- DESIRED OUTCOMES
- No homeless in Camas.
- CPD and City Staff are trained and have access to support programs and resources to support those in need.

- UNWANTED CONSEQUENCES
- Not financially sustainable.
- Program solution meets the program needs rather than create more problems.

## **NEXT STEPS FOR CAMAS**

- Discussion with council.
- Frequently Asked Questions response sheet developed and distributed to staff and council. Final draft in progress.
- Council consider adopting the new CMC(Camas Municipal Code) Chapter 12.34 related to unlawful camping and storage of personal property on public property that effectively offers support to the homeless while protecting city parks, open spaces, public property to ensure intended use and in compliance with State and Federal laws. This proposed ordinance is in progress and will be discussed at a future workshop meeting.
- Mayor, CA, and Police Chief identify and train appropriate staff to know how to offer resources and/or enforce city code and ordinance.
- Encourage the mayor's work with ECHO, <u>Ending Community Homelessness</u>
  Organization, and it's partners and providers to help facilitate connection to proper services for those in need.
- Explore multi-agency Inter-Local Agreements.


