RCW 35A.12.120

Council—Quorum—Rules—Voting.

At all meetings of the council a majority of the councilmembers shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, but a less number may adjourn from time to time and may compel the attendance of absent members in such manner and under such penalties as may be prescribed by ordinance. The council shall determine its own rules and order of business, and may establish rules for the conduct of council meetings and the maintenance of order. At the desire of any member, any question shall be voted upon by roll call and the ayes and nays shall be recorded in the journal.

The passage of any ordinance, grant or revocation of franchise or license, and any resolution for the payment of money shall require the affirmative vote of at least a majority of the whole membership of the council. [2009 c 549 § 3012; 1967 ex.s. c 119 § 35A.12.120.]

The city council shall meet on the first and third Mondays of each month at the hour of seven p.m.; provided, however, that in the event either of said Mondays shall fall on a legal holiday, as designated in RCW 1.16.050, such council meeting shall be held on the following Tuesday at the same hour; and provided further, that in those years that a fourth Monday shall be December 24th, such council meeting shall be held on the following Wednesday at the same hour.

2.04.050 - Workshops.

The city council shall conduct workshop meetings on the first and third Mondays of each month at the hour of four-thirty p.m.; provided, however, that in the event either of such Mondays shall fall on a legal holiday as designated in RCW 1.16.050, such workshop meetings shall be held on the following Tuesday at the same hour. No final action as that term is defined in the Open Public Meetings Act shall be taken at any workshop meeting.
