Chapter 2.38 - SALARY COMMISSION

A member of the commission shall serve for a four-year term without compensation. The initial membership shall be appointed for staggered terms with one member serving a two-year term, two members serving three-year terms and two members serving four-year terms. No member of the commission shall be appointed for more than two terms. (Note: Thereafter, every person appointed to such committee shall serve a fouryear term; this is not included on adopted ordinance)
