ORDINANCE NO. 9-25

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMDEN, ARKANSAS, FIXING THE RATE OF TAXATION FOR THE YEAR 2026; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMDEN, ARKANSAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. Upon each and every dollar of taxable property, both real and personal, there shall be and is hereby levied the following rate of taxation for the year 2026:

- 1. For defraying the general expense of the City, known as taxes for general purposes:
 - 5.0 mills on the dollar for real property.
 - 5.0 mills on the dollar for personal property.
- 2. For creating a fund to be used for the payment of firemen's pensions:
 - 1.0 mills on the dollar for real property.
 - 1.0 mills on the dollar for personal property.
- 3. For creating a fund to be used for the payment of policemen's pensions:
 - 1.0 mills on the dollar for real property.
 - 1.0 mills on the dollar for personal property.
- 4. For creating a fund to be used for maintenance of a public library:
 - 1.0 mills on the dollar for real property.
 - 1.0 mills on the dollar for personal property.

SECTION 2. The County Clerk of Ouachita County, Arkansas, on receipt of a duly certified copy of this Ordinance from the City Clerk of the City of Camden, is directed to enter upon the tax books of Ouachita County, Arkansas, for the year 2026, the foregoing rate of taxation by which all property, both real and personal, is assessed in the City of Camden, and the Collector of Ouachita County, Arkansas, is directed to collect said taxes and pay over to the Treasurer of the City of Camden the respective amounts so collected and found due to said City on his statement with the County Clerk of Ouachita County, Arkansas.

SECTION 3. It is recognized that according to the provisions of Arkansas Code Ann. § 26-26-406, the County Clerk of Ouachita County, Arkansas, has the statutory authority to make base year adjustments to the millage levy for personal property outlined above.

SECTION 4. It is ascertained that the time for making the levy of these taxes for the year 2026 is about to expire and in order to prevent the loss of revenues to the City of Camden, it is necessary that this Ordinance take effect immediately; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

ORDINANCE NO. 10-25

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF FRANCHISE FEES BY ARKANSAS RURAL INTERNET SERVICES, LLC; GRANTING TO ARKANSAS RURAL INTERNET SERVICES, LLC A FRANCHISE TO CONSTRUCT, OPERATE, AND MAINTAIN A DATA TRANSMISSION SERVICES SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF CAMDEN, ARKANSAS; SETTING FORTH CONDITIONS ACCOMPANYING THE GRANT OF THE FRANCHISE; PROVIDING FOR REGULATION AND USE OF THE SYSTEM AND THE PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS HEREIN; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Camden (the "City") is a city of the first class, organized and existing under and pursuant to the law of the State of Arkansas (the "State"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated Section 14-200-101 (the "Statute"), the City is authorized to charge a franchise fee (the "Fee") to public utilities for which the public utilities may be permitted to occupy the streets, highways, or other public places within the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the statute, Arkansas Rural Internet Services, LLC is allowed to consent to entering into a franchise agreement for data transmission services and desires to do so; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas Rural Internet Services, LLC desires to provide data transmission services system (the "System"), including but not limited to internet services within the City, through underground fiber optic cables; and

WHEREAS, such development can contribute significantly to the communication needs and desires of the residents and citizens of City and the public generally; and

WHEREAS, the City may achieve better utilization and improvement of public services and enhanced economic development with the development and operation of the System; and

WHEREAS, subject to the terms hereof, to be recognized as the Franchise Agreement, the City is willing to allow Arkansas Rural Internet Services, LLC, and its affiliates, designees, or assigns, the privilege of using the right-of-way of the City's streets, highways, and other public places in the City for a period of ten (10) years (the "Franchise") and to establish franchise fees to be paid by Arkansas Rural Internet Services, LLC; and

WHEREAS, adoption of this Ordinance granting the Franchise is in the best interests of the City and its residents.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMDEN, ARKANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Rural Internet Services, LLC, and its affiliates, designees, and assigns, may use the right-of-way of the City's streets, highways, and other public places in the City for the purpose of providing data transmission services, including but not limited to internet services to customers through underground fiber optic cables, for a period of ten (10) years.

SECTION 2. For privilege of using the right-of-way of the City's streets, highways, and other public places, Arkansas Rural Internet Services, LLC shall (a) pay to the City franchise fees in the amount of four and a quarter percent (4.25%) of its current year's gross revenues collected from customers located in the corporate limits of the City; and (b) after the City's payment of a one-time hook-up charge not to exceed the actual cost thereof, provide access of fiber optic data services to all City departments without additional charge.

SECTION 3. The franchise fees levied by this Ordinance shall be payable by Arkansas Rural Internet Services, LLC quarterly each year with payment being due no later than the 15th day of the month following the end of each quarter of the year.

SECTION 4. If it becomes necessary for the City to expand its use of the rights-of-way of the City's streets, highways or other public places, then Arkansas Rural Internet Services, LLC, on the request of the City, shall relocate or raise or lower its fiber optic cables in the rights-of-way of the City's streets, highways or other public places. The expense of such removal, relocation, raising or lowering of the fiber optic cables shall be paid by Arkansas Rural Internet Services, LLC. Arkansas Rural Internet Services, LLC shall remove, relocate, raise or lower its fiber optic cables in the rights-of-way of City's streets, highways or other public places within ninety (90) days of the notice by the City to do so.

SECTION 5. The rights provided herein for the use of the City's rights-of-way shall be non-exclusive. Nothing contained in this Ordinance shall be construed as giving Arkansas Rural Internet Services, LLC any exclusive privileges.

SECTION 6. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be separate, and if any provision shall for any reason be held illegal or invalid, it shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance may be codified in the Code of Ordinances and the sections may be renumbered or redesignated to accomplish such intention.

SECTION 8. (EMERGENCY CLAUSE). It is hereby found that Arkansas Rural Internet Services, LLC desires to provide data transmission services through underground fiber optic cables to the citizens of the City immediately and that it cannot access the City's rights-of-way without permission of the City, all of which is necessary for the public peace, health, and safety of the City, its inhabitants, and their property. It is, therefore, declared that an emergency exists and this Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance may be codified in the Code of Ordinances and the sections may be renumbered or redesignated to accomplish such intention.

SECTION 8. (EMERGENCY CLAUSE). It is hereby found that South Arkansas Telephone Company, Inc d/b/a Air Cast desires to provide data transmission services through underground fiber optic cables to the citizens of the City immediately and that it cannot access the City's rights-of-way without permission of the City, all of which is necessary for the public peace, health, and safety of the City, its inhabitants, and their property. It is, therefore, declared that an emergency exists and this Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage.

RESOLUTION NO. 37-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMDEN, ARKANSAS AMENDING THE OPERATING BUDGET FOR 2025; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the 2025 annual operating budget included \$555,816 in line item 1-120-59440 (capital outlay - auto) for the purchase of a pumper truck for the Camden Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the pumper truck was less than anticipated in the budget; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to use the remaining surplus funds for the purchase of an ambulance for the Camden Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the capital outlay detail for line item 1-120-59440 should be amended to include the purchase of an ambulance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMDEN, ARKANSAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The 2025 annual operating budget is amended by adding an ambulance to the capital outlay detail in line item 1-120-59440.

SECTION 2. Services provided to Camden residents will only be billed through insurance providers.

SECTION 3. Services provided to non-residents of Camden will be charged a rate based upon similar services in the region.

SECTION 4. The revenue received for ambulance services shall be designated for the purchase of Camden Fire Department equipment, supplies and training.
