Lucinda Gonzales requests water utility services for a cabin that is located at 1608 North 15th Street. She also states that the cabin was custom built for her brother to reside in. The cabin's electricity was installed by a certified electrician.

Ms. Gonzalez states that she spoke to City Manager Azalia Garcia regarding the utility services for the cabin. City Manager Azalia Garcia states that it is not a manufactured home and needs to be in compliance before the city can provide utility services. Ms. Gonzales states that Code Enforcer Arnold Aguilar has not been to the home to inspect the cabin.

Mayor Oscar E. Puente states that the cabin does not meet the 800 square footage requirement and the cabin would need to be made into an 800 square foot home to be in compliance.

Lucinda Gonzales would like to know if she has to pay for the water meter and states that she will pay for the meter for the utility services.
