## **2. DISCUSSION AND APPROPRIATE ACTION IN REGARDS TO THE CITY OF CARRIZO SPRINGS & DIMMIT COUNTY INTERLOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGREEMENT**

Sheriff Marion Boyd states to Council that he did not know how much the city owed the county. The new agreement will be \$350,000 for law enforcement services and \$100,000 of that amount will go towards the debt owed to the county in arrears in the amount of \$667,737.

Councilor Jesse Johnson states that he is against abolishing the City Marshal's department to balance the budget.

Councilor Benny Rocha states that he took it upon himself to find out how much in debt the city was with Dimmit County. Councilor Rocha states that he does not want people to lose their jobs or positions, but the budget is in a deficit.

Motion made by Councilor Jesse Johnson, second by Councilor Oscar E. Puente to approve the City of Carrizo Springs & Dimmit County Interlocal Law Enforcement agreement for \$350,000 with \$100,000 to be applied towards arrears totaling \$667,737.

Vote for approval 5-0 (unanimous).

Motion made by Councilor Jesse Johnson, second by Councilor Benny Rocha to approve contract with amendments as requested by Council.

Motion made by Councilor Sandra C. Little, second by Councilor Benny Rocha to approve service agreement between the City of Carrizo Springs & Carrizo Springs High School ROTC to paint the City of Carrizo Springs fire hydrants at \$10 per hydrant and for the city to provide paint and brushes.
